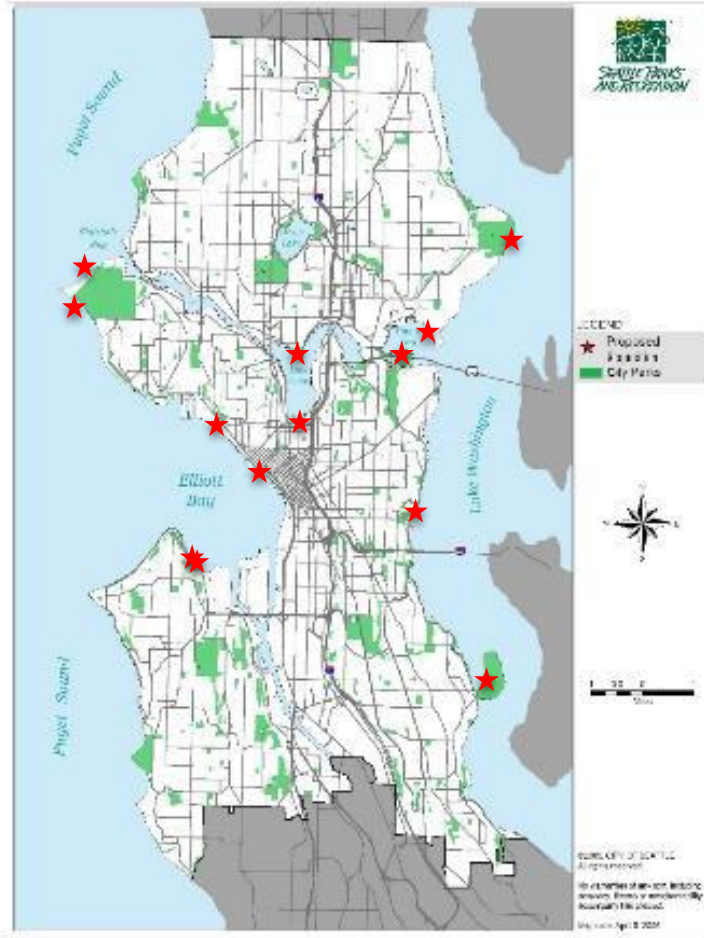

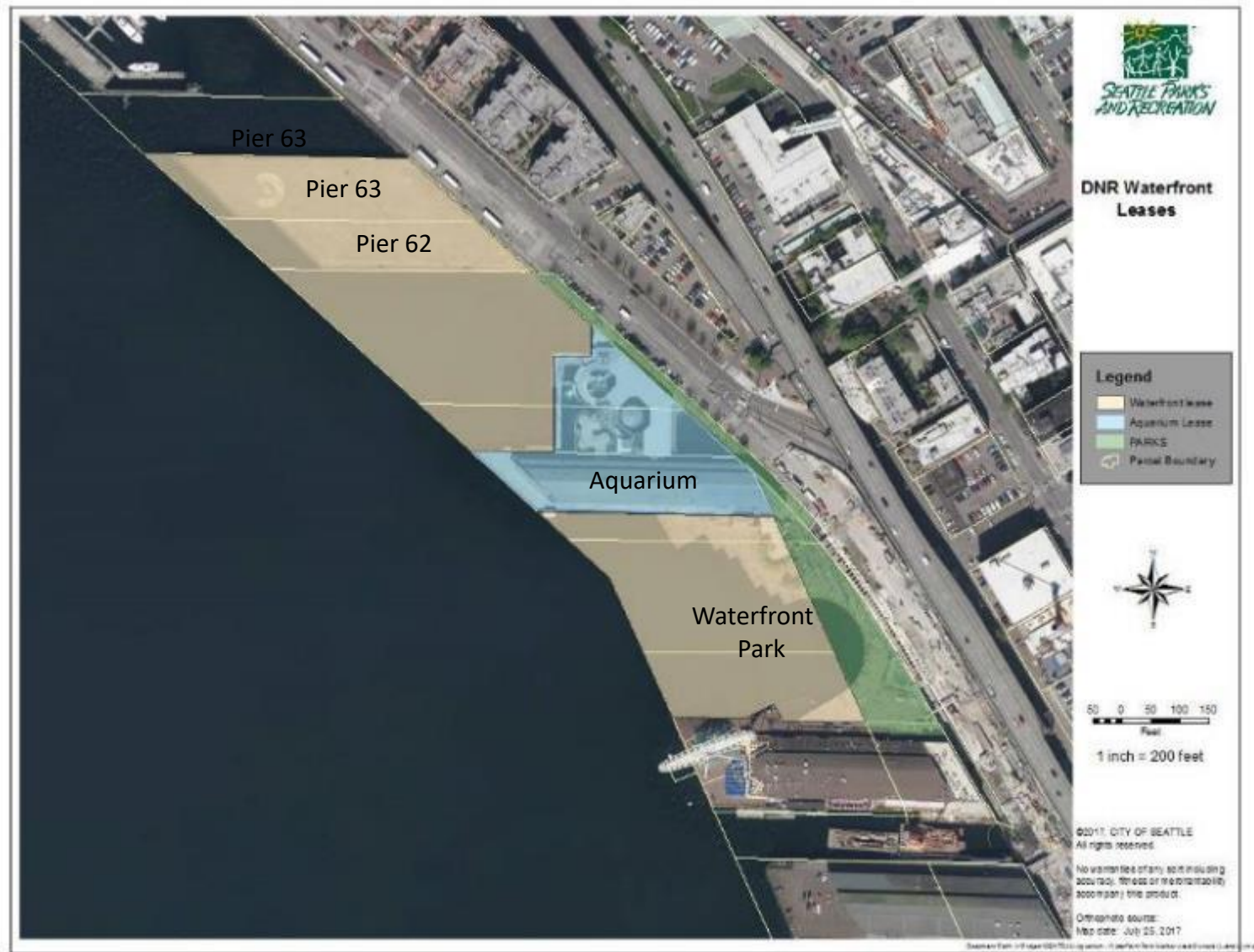

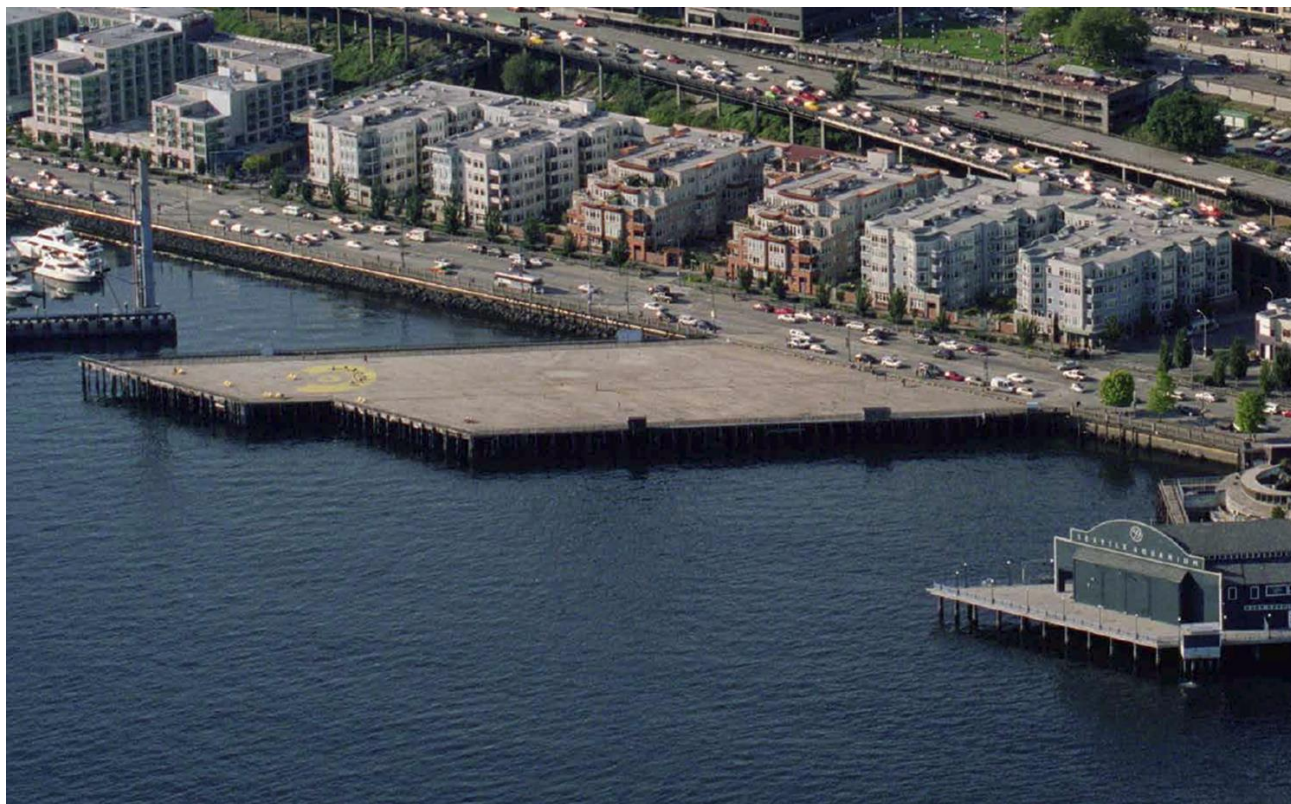

Pier 62 Rebuild

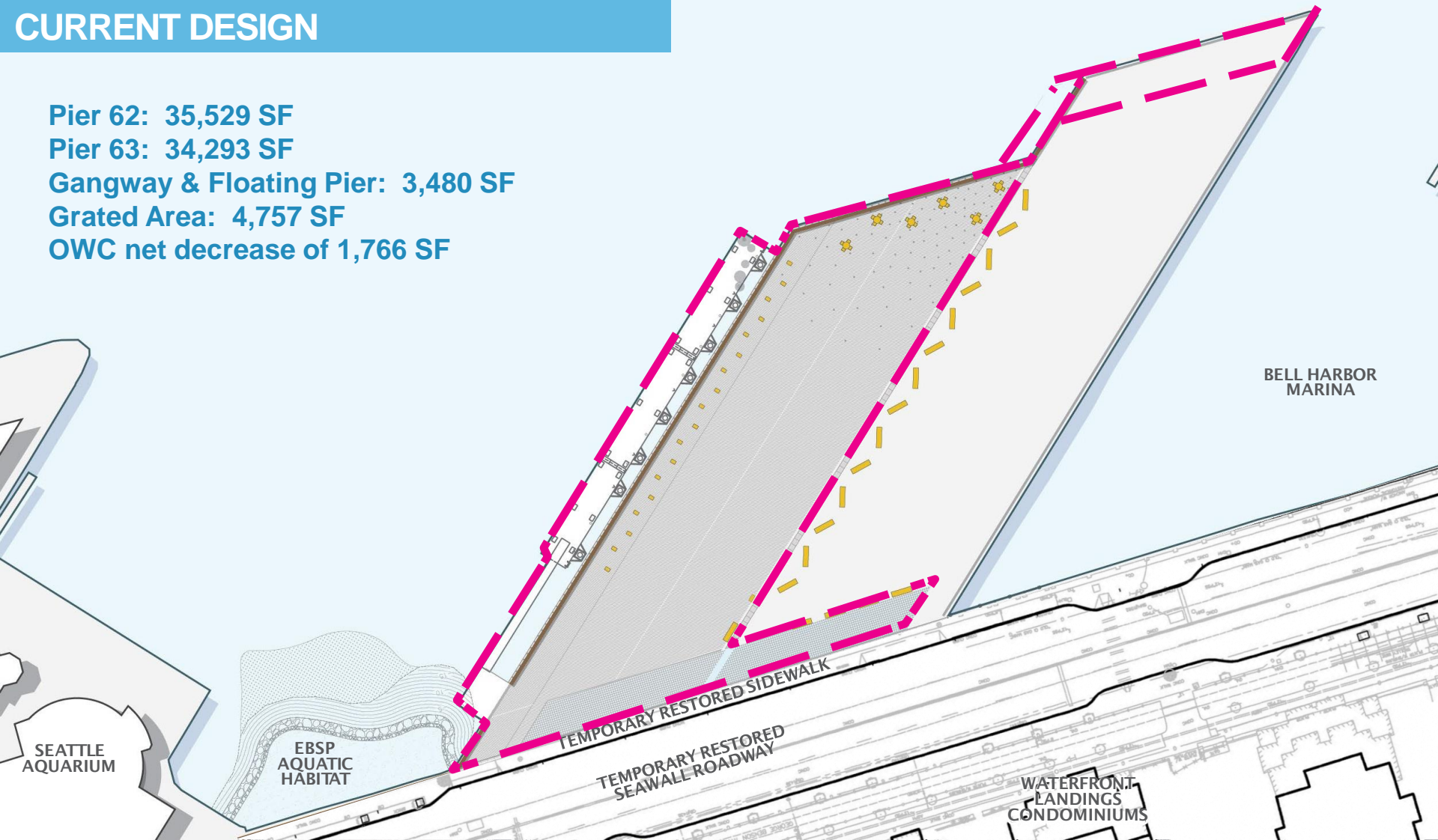

2017: PIER 62/63 REBUILD CURRENT DESIGN

- Pier 62: 35,529 SF
- Pier 63: 34,293 SF
- Gangway & Floating Pier: 3,480 SF
- Grated Area: 4,757 SF
- OWC net decrease of 1,766 SF



DNR Waterfront Lease

The Proposed Ordinance:

This Ordinance authorizes the Superintendent of Parks and Recreation, on behalf of the City of Seattle (“City”), to execute a Lease agreement with the State of Washington, Department of Natural Resources and authorizing the City to use the property as a public park providing recreational and educational opportunities for all citizens and visitors to the region.
