AN ORDINANCE increasing civil assessments for failure to timely file reports; amending Seattle Municipal Code Sections 2.04.330.

Summary of the Legislation:

This legislation increases from \$50 to \$150 the maximum penalty for late filing a report in the closing days of an election campaign, and increases from \$10 to \$50 the maximum penalty for late filing a report at any other time.

At its January meeting, the Commission decided that the late-filing penalties – which have not changed since 1997 – were no longer at a level that deterred campaigns from filing late reports.
