# Background

- Ordinance 125471 requires Council approval to apply for grants above \$5 million, except for listed projects
- SDOT plans to seek \$5M+ WSDOT Regional Mobility Grant funding for the Market/45<sup>th</sup> Multimodal Corridor Project
  - Project # TC367790 in 2018-2023 CIP
- Regional Mobility Grant Application due July 13, 2018
