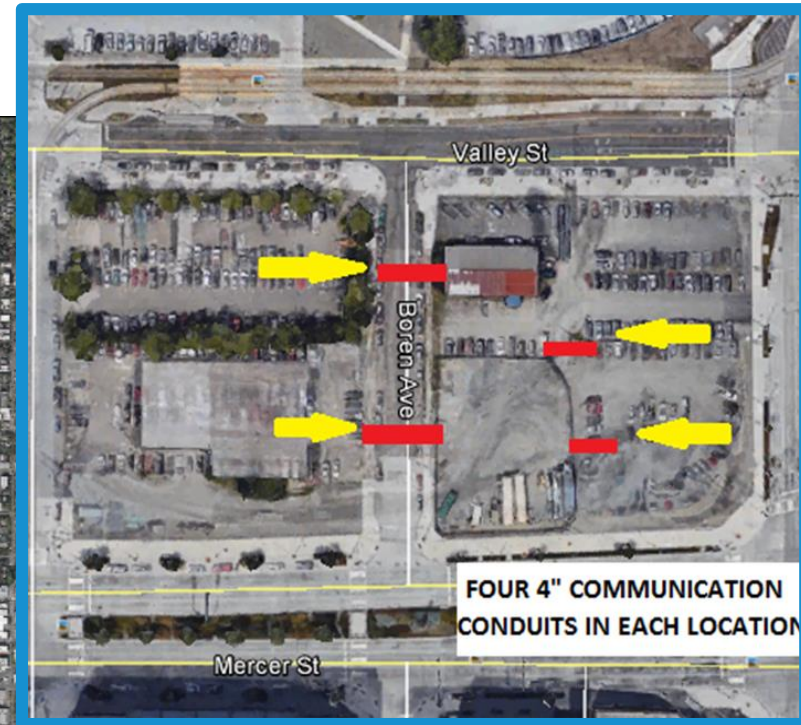
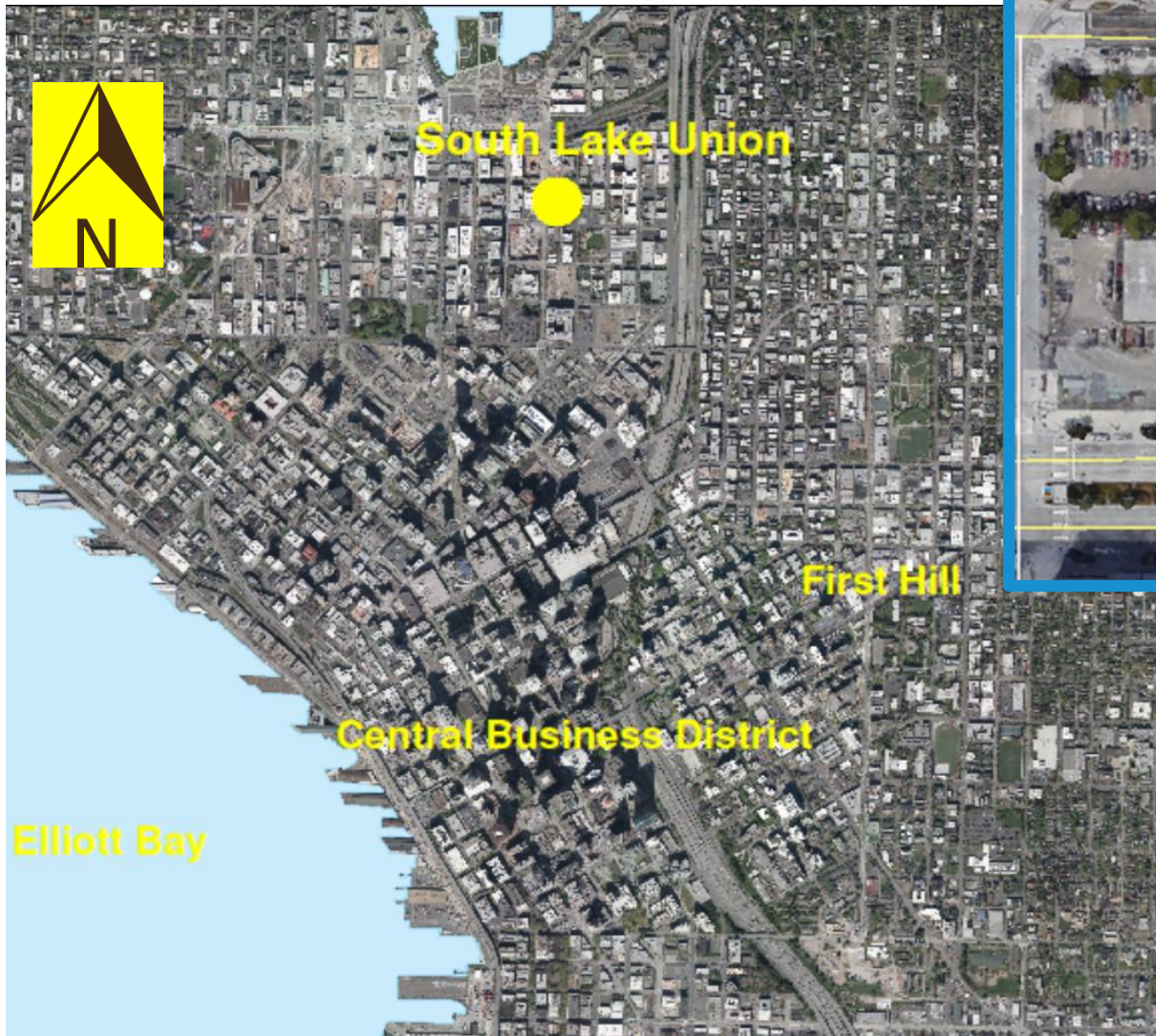
# Proposal

Lakefront Investors 2 LLC is seeking a new permit as conceptually approved by Resolution 31742 for four sets of private communication conduits under Boren Ave N, north of Mercer St, and in the alley between Boren Ave N and Fairview Ave N

- These conduits provide:
  - Secure data transmission between the buildings; and
  - A high level of security for tenant's intellectual property and customer data
- SDOT recommends approval of the resolution

# Term permit process and background

☑ Step 1: Resolution 31742 – Conceptual Approval

☑ Step 2: Ordinance – Final Approval

Passage of the ordinance details the terms and conditions of the permit, including annual fee, maintenance obligations, indemnification, insurance, and bond requirements.

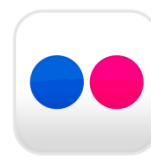
# Requested Action
