


- Mercy Housing Northwest (MHNW) is proposing to redevelop the existing Sand Point Naval Station barracks (Building 9) at Magnuson Park for low income housing.
- Due to the site configuration, Mercy is unable to provide the required secondary emergency access on their property.




- Mercy is requesting a permanent emergency access easement across Parks and Recreation property.
- Based on an independent appraisal, Mercy will pay \$32,000 for the easement.
- Simultaneously, Mercy is granting the City an easement over a portion of the Mercy property to provide two additional parking spaces for park users.
