Presentation overview



- The Fred Hutchinson Cancer Center seeks to renew a permit for an existing pedestrian skybridge and tunnel at Eastlake Ave E, north of Aloha St
- The skybridge connects the Vaccine and Infectious Disease Division and the Weintraub Basic Sciences Building
- Fred Hutch is researching the links between cancer and infectious disease - the skybridge supports staff moving between lab facilities
- The tunnel provides a private utility and service personnel connection between the two buildings
- SDOT recommends renewal of the two term permits

Term permit process – permit renewals



Ordinance Passage:

- Renews the permit for 15 years
- Details the terms and conditions of the permit, including:
 - a) Annual fee
 - b) Maintenance obligations
 - c) Indemnification, insurance, and insurance requirements.

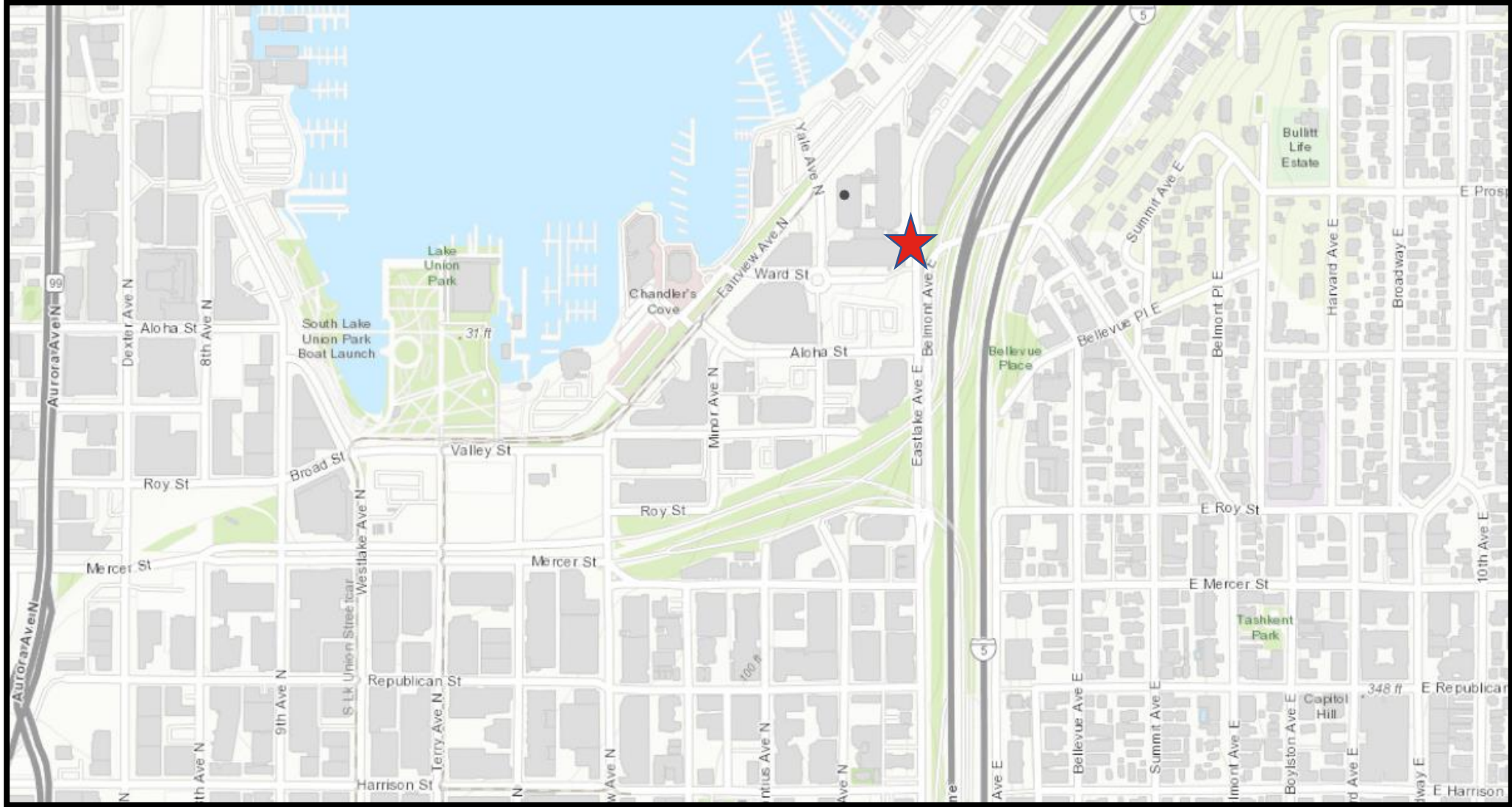
