1. BILL SUMMARY

Legislation Title:

AN ORDINANCE amending the 2015 Adopted Budget, including the 2015-2020 Capital Improvement Program (CIP); changing appropriations to various departments and from various funds in the Budget; revising project allocations for certain projects in the 2015-2020 CIP; and ratifying and confirming certain prior acts; all by a 3/4 vote of the City Council.

Summary and background of the Legislation:

This legislation appropriates unexpended non-capital appropriations from the 2014 Budget to the 2015 Budget.

RCW 35.32A.080 states: "the whole or any part of any appropriation provided in the budget for operating and maintenance expenses remaining unexpended or unencumbered at the close of the fiscal year shall automatically lapse, except any such appropriation as the city council shall continue by ordinance." This legislation requests continuances for unexpended 2014 appropriations for non-capital purposes in the amount of \$7.5 million. Appropriations were made in the 2014 Budget for these expenditures but for various reasons, spending was not initiated or completed during the 2014 fiscal year. This ordinance re-appropriates these funds, which lapsed at the end of 2014, in most cases for the same purposes that the funds were dedicated to in 2014.
