

Background: <i>Daniel Damian Pak was born and raised on O`ahu and is a fourth generation Korean American and fifth generation Japanese American. Learning to play the piano and the ukulele at a very young age, music was always a big part of Pak's life. In the fourth grade he played the role of Shere Khan in his elementary school's production of The Jungle Book, including a solo performance of Michael Jackson's "Bad."</i> <i>After moving to Seattle to attend the University of Washington, Pak fronted two college bands while earning a bachelor's degree in metallurgical engineering. Graduating "with distinction," Pak turned down an offer to work as a nuclear engineer and bartended downtown while writing songs to front his new band Kore Ionz. The band released its first record in 2008 and has since shared the stage with The Wailers, Toots and the Maytals, Steel Pulse, Sly & Robbie, and Third World, among others. The band has released five records and four music videos to date and performed three times at Bumbershoot. The Seattle Weekly describes Pak's voice as sounding "like it was birthed right in the heart of New Orleans, with enough jazz heart to lead a Jamaican revolution of peace and love."</i>
