of Seattle for a period of up to 30 years.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY OF SEATTLE AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. The CEO and General Manager for the City Light Department is authorized for and on behalf of The City of Seattle to execute and deliver a two-year agreement with the Port of Seattle for the construction of the Project in the form of a Memorandum of Agreement (MOA) attached to this ordinance as Attachment A (the "Agreement") with such changes as the CEO and General Manager may deem appropriate and are consistent with this ordinance.

Section 2. The CEO and General Manager for the City Light Department is authorized for and on behalf of The City of Seattle to negotiate and execute a separate Operations

Agreement between the Port of Seattle and Seattle City Light detailing the responsibilities for operations, routine inspection, and maintenance of the submarine cable that is owned by the Port

Section 3. Any act consistent with the authority of this ordinance taken prior to its effective date is ratified and confirmed.
