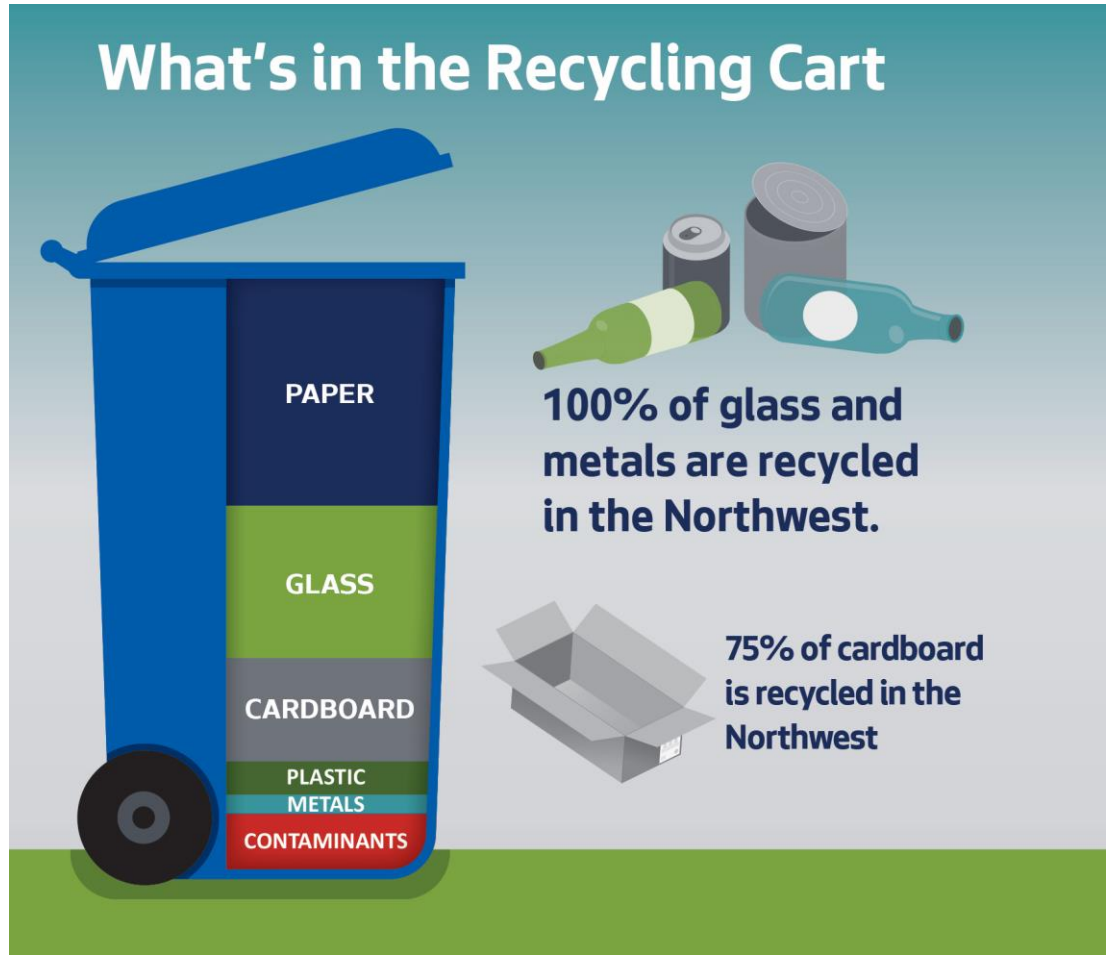

# Purpose:

**To secure Council approval of an ordinance authorizing SPU to enter into an interlocal agreement resolving a dispute with King County regarding waste disposal from recycling facilities.**



# Overview



# Leading up to the ILA

- In 2018, King County directed companies to send residuals to the King County Landfill
- The City and County met to discuss the issue but could not resolve
- The City initiated a lawsuit to obtain a declaratory judgement
- Discussions continued and the ILA is being proposed



# Interlocal Agreement

- All residuals will be disposed of through the city's disposal system
- The City will make a program support payment of \$30 per ton to the County for the portion that comes from King County
- Agreement results in additional City program support of \$200K/yr
- The City or the County can dissolve the ILA at any time with proper notice.
