A. in Liberal Arts from Goddard College, where he completed the oral history project entitled "Boston Area Transgender Community Leaders and the ENDA Crisis." Gunner brings over a decade of experience leading change in the LGBTQ community along with extensive experience public policy development, program management, public education and training, legislative campaigns, fundraising, and communications. Prior to living in Seattle, he was the Executive Director of the Massachusetts Transgender Political Coalition (MTPC) where he led a five-year legislative campaign for the Transgender Equal Rights bill, which passed the Massachusetts legislature in 2011.									
He has also written articles for Boston Phoenix and Bay Windows newspapers, What's Up magazine, and Sojourner Women's Forum. He penned "Agitate and Activate," the introduction to Pinned Down by Pronouns, a 2003 Lambda Literary-nominated anthology and he is a co-author on the study and 2011 American Journal of Public Health article "Transgender Health in Massachusetts: Results from a Household Probability Sample of Adults."
