# East Marginal Way Corridor Improvement Project

**Grant Award:** \$20 million RAISE grant

**Local Match:** \$33.9 million

**Port of Seattle Contribution:** \$5.5 million

**Project Impact:** Improvements to the corridor include:

- Reconstruct roadway to meet heavy haul network standards along 1.1-mile segment
- Construct 2-way protected bike lane along 1.4-mile segment
- Rebuild a portion of the sidewalk
- Construct new traffic signals to enhance safety

# Sidewalk Improvements on 4<sup>th</sup> Ave S

**Grant Award:** \$247,000

Transportation Improvement  
Board grant

**Local Match:** \$130,016

**Project Impact:** Project constructs a new sidewalk on 4<sup>th</sup> Ave S near the I-90 to provide a seamless walkway between downtown, the stadium district, and numerous bus stops along the corridor.
