# Proposal

Virginia Mason Medical Center is seeking permit renewal of existing pedestrian skybridge over Seneca St, west of Terry Ave for third and final term:

- Provides pedestrian connection between the Lindeman Pavilion outpatient services and the main hospital facility
- Allows for the transfer of patients, visitors, hospital staff, and specialized hospital equipment between the two medical facilities without crossing at the street
- SDOT recommends approval

*Skybridge located over and across Seneca St, west of Terry Ave, connecting Virginia Mason Main Hospital and the Lindeman Pavilion*




# Background

## Term permit history

- Initial approval granted May 1995, and renewed May 2005
- This renewal updates the permit and inspection fees and insurance requirements, and adjusts the bond amount to an amount equivalent for removal
- Final term will expire May 2025, continuation after this date will require new skybridge application and public benefit mitigation proposal
