19	Section 1. A hearing by the Seattle City Council for the petition to vacate a portion of the					
20	alley in Block 24, Pontius Fourth Addition to the City of Seattle has been scheduled to take place					
21	during the Council's Transportation Committee meeting on Tuesday, April 2, 2024, starting at					
22	9:30 a.m., in the City Council Chambers, Floor 2, City Hall. The Transportation Committee will					
23	consider the petition when Clerk File 314512 is before the committee according to the Committee's
