Generally speaking, between the date range 2012 – 2014, Anti-Gay & Lesbian category represents the most frequent bias crime. In the 2nd Half of 2014 Anti-Gay accounted for 24% of the 54 total reported crimes, Anti-black represents 22% of the total, while Anti-White represents 19% of the total.

Overall, no dramatic trends with respect to the types of incidents reported. The data appears to be fairly consistent over time. However, the last 18 months has shown an overall average increase in reporting (62) bias incidents per six month period city-wide, in comparison to the prior 18 months which averaged only (50) bias incidents per six month period city-wide.

The East Precinct (Capitol Hill) had the highest percentage of incidents of bias crime in the First Half of 2014. However, during the 2nd Half of 2014, the East Precinct experienced an overall drop in reported bias incidents. Their numbers moved from 23 bias incidents or 38% of the total in the 1st Half of 2014 to 11 bias incidents or 17% of the total in the 2nd Half of 2014. This represents a 52% drop in reported bias incidents over the first half of the year. While this drop may be attributed to East Precinct emphasis patrols, year over year numbers are comparable to the 2nd Half of 2013, which had 10 bias incidents or 16% of the total.

Overview

During the second half of 2014, 66 bias incidents were reported to the Seattle Police Department. This is 10% higher than the last reporting period which had 60 bias incidents city wide.

Incidents

- ✓ 31 of the incidents were determined to be Malicious Harassment
- ✓ 23 of the incidents were determined to be crimes with bias elements
- ✓ 12 of the incidents were determined to be non-criminal bias incidents

Arrests

- ✓ Of the 31 Malicious Harassment related crimes
 - o 9 were arrested and/or charged with a felony crime
 - o 2 were arrested and/or charged with a misdemeanor offense
 - o 1 case was cleared exceptional due to the victim's family not wanting to prosecute (juvenile).
 - o 16 cases were inactivated or administratively cleared due to solvability or other factors pending further information.
 - o 3 cases remain open and active
- ✓ Of the 23 crimes with bias elements related incidents
 - o 2 were arrested and/or charged with a felony crime
 - o 7 were arrested and/or charged with a misdemeanor offense

- o 1 case was cleared exceptional- the victim did not want to prosecute
- 13 cases were inactivated or administratively cleared due to solvability or other factors pending further information
