WHEREAS, the Landmarks Preservation Ordinance, Chapter 25.12 of the Seattle Municipal |
| 11                         | Code (SMC), establishes a procedure for the designation and preservation of sites,  |

| 14                         | WHEREAS, the Landmarks Preservation Board (Board), after a public meeting on June 4, 2014,  |
| 15                         | voted to approve the nomination of the improvement located at 925 Alaskan Way and the   |
| 16                         | site on which the improvement is located (which collectively are referred to as "Fire   |
| 17                         | Station No. 5" for the purposes of this ordinance) for designation as a landmark under  |
| 18                         | SMC Chapter 25.12; and  |
| 19                         | WHEREAS, after a public meeting on July 16, 2014, the Board voted to approve the designation  |
| 20                         | of Fire Station No. 5 under SMC Chapter 25.12; and  |
| 21                         | WHEREAS, on May 6, 2015, the Board and the owner of the designated landmark agreed to   |
| 22                         | controls and incentives; and  |
| 23                         | WHEREAS, the Board recommends that the City Council enact a designating ordinance   |
| 24                         | approving the controls and incentives; NOW, THEREFORE,  |
| 25                         | BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY OF SEATTLE AS FOLLOWS:   |
| 26                         | Section 1. <u>DESIGNATION</u> : Pursuant to Seattle Municipal Code (SMC) 25.12.660, the   |
| 27                         | designation by the Landmarks Preservation Board (Board) of the improvement located at 925   |

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Section 2. <u>CONTROLS</u>: The following controls are hereby imposed on the features or characteristics of Fire Station No. 5 that were designated by the Board for preservation:

# A. <u>Certificate of Approval Process</u>.

- 1. Except as provided in subsection 2.A.2 or subsection 2.B, the owner must obtain a Certificate of Approval issued by the Board pursuant to SMC Chapter 25.12, or the time for denying a Certificate of Approval must have expired, before the owner may make alterations or significant changes to the specific features or characteristics of Fire Station No. 5 designated in subsection 1.B.
  - 2. No Certificate of Approval is required for the following:
- a. Any in-kind maintenance or repairs of the features or characteristics listed in subsection 2.A.1.
- b. Any work to repave or replace the pier concrete deck resulting from or related to the Elliott Bay Seawall Replacement Project No. 3013171.
  - B. City Historic Preservation Officer Approval Process.
- 1. The City Historic Preservation Officer (CHPO) may review and approve alterations or significant changes to the features or characteristics listed in subsection 2.B.3 according to the following procedure:
- a. The owner shall submit to the CHPO a written request for the alterations or significant changes, including applicable drawings or specifications.
- b. If the CHPO, upon examination of submitted plans and specifications, determines that the alterations or significant changes are consistent with the purposes of SMC Chapter 25.12, the CHPO shall approve the alterations or significant changes without further action by the Board.

- Uses not otherwise permitted in a zone may be authorized in a designated Α. Landmark by means of an administrative conditional use permit issued pursuant to SMC Title 23.
- Certain exceptions to or exemptions from regulation in SMC Title 23 may be B. available, either by virtue of the zoning designation applicable to the landmark or its status as a landmark.
- Special tax valuation for historic preservation may be available under RCW C. Chapter 84.26 upon application and compliance with the requirements of that statute.
- D. Exceptions to certain requirements of the Seattle Building Code, SMC Chapter 22.100, and the Seattle Energy Code, SMC Chapter 22.700, may be authorized pursuant to the applicable provisions thereof.
- Section 4. Enforcement of this ordinance and penalties for its violation are as provided in SMC 25.12.910.
- Section 5. Fire Station No. 5 is hereby added alphabetically to Section II, Buildings, of the Table of Historical Landmarks contained in SMC Chapter 25.32.
- Section 6. The City Clerk is directed to record a certified copy of this ordinance with the King County Director of Records and Elections, deliver two certified copies to the CHPO, and deliver one copy to the Director of the Seattle Department of Construction and Inspections. The CHPO is directed to provide a certified copy of the ordinance to the owner of the landmark.
