

Amendment 1
to
RES 32033 – URM Retrofit Program
Sponsor: Herbold
Public Development Authority

<p>Effect: This amendment would add a public development authority as a potential contractor to provide coaching for URM owners and serve as a general resource for residents and building owners about the future URM retrofit program.</p>

Amend Section 3 of Resolution 32033, as follows:

Section 3. The Mayor shall direct the Seattle Department of Construction and Inspections (“SDCI”) and the Office of Emergency Management (“OEM”) to pursue the following actions that will result in implementing a mandatory URM seismic retrofit program:

A. Provide ongoing funding for any additional staff necessary to establish and maintain the program and for technical experts who can assess and approve proposed upgrade plans;

H. Work with a public development authority or nongovernmental URM contractor to develop resources to provide coaching for owners of URM’s and serve as a general resource for residents and building owners about the program;

I. Prepare a communication strategy; and

J. Submit legislation establishing the mandatory URM retrofit program for Council consideration.
