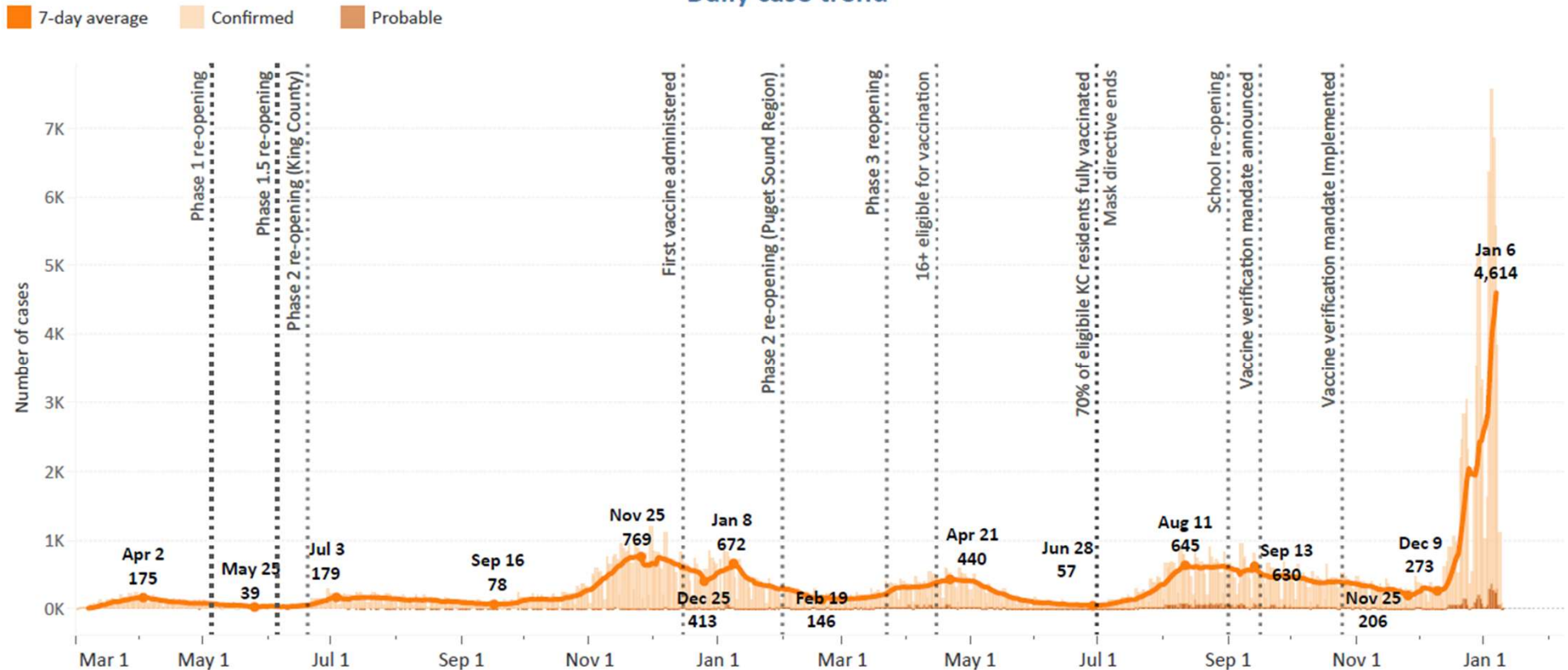

### Daily case trend

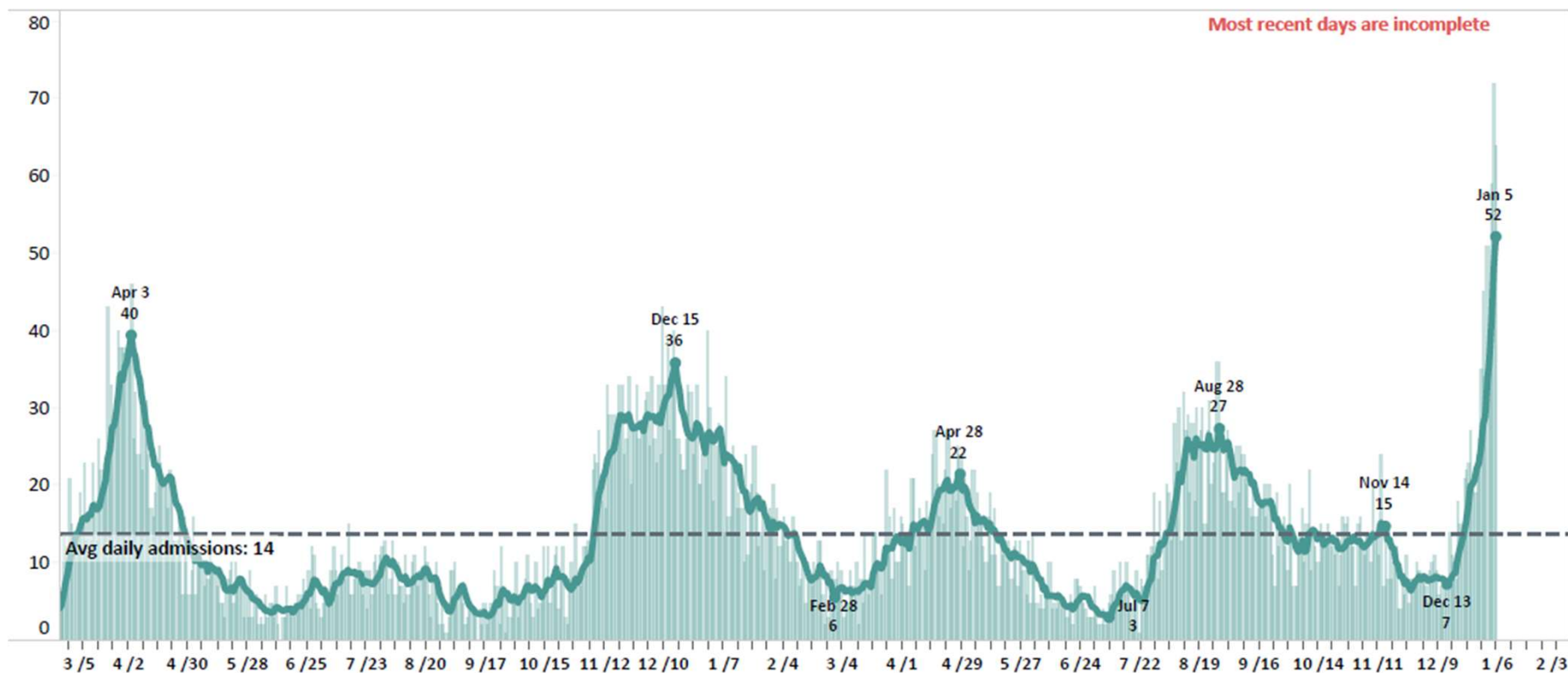




## Summary of COVID-19 hospitalizations Monday, January 10, 2022

Over the last week, there has been an **increasing** trend of hospitalizations (n=366) by **110.3%**  compared to the previous week (n=174)

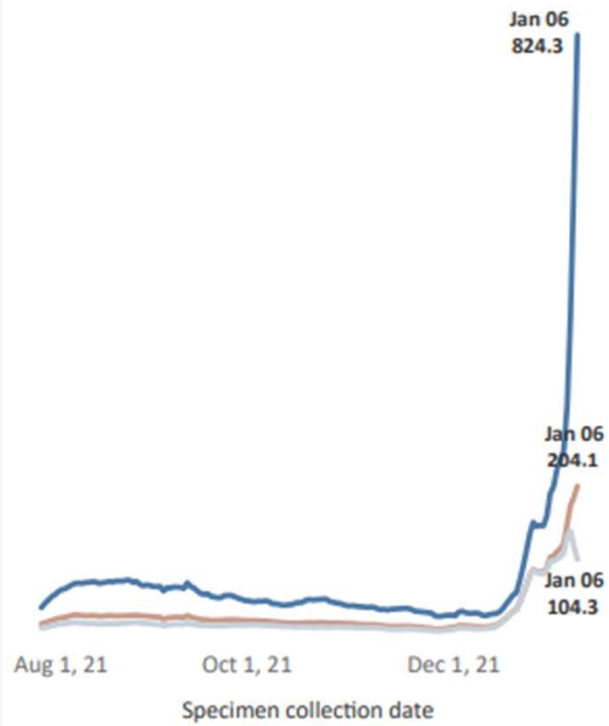
### Daily hospital admissions among PCR positive cases in King County, WA



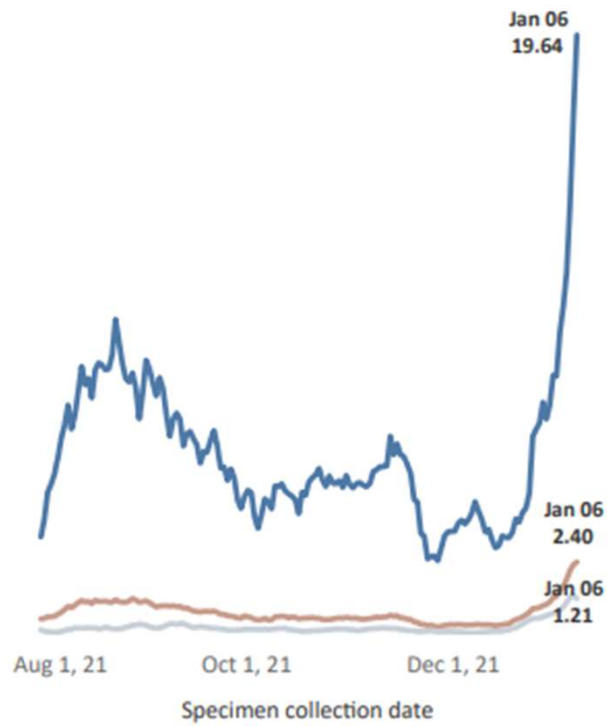

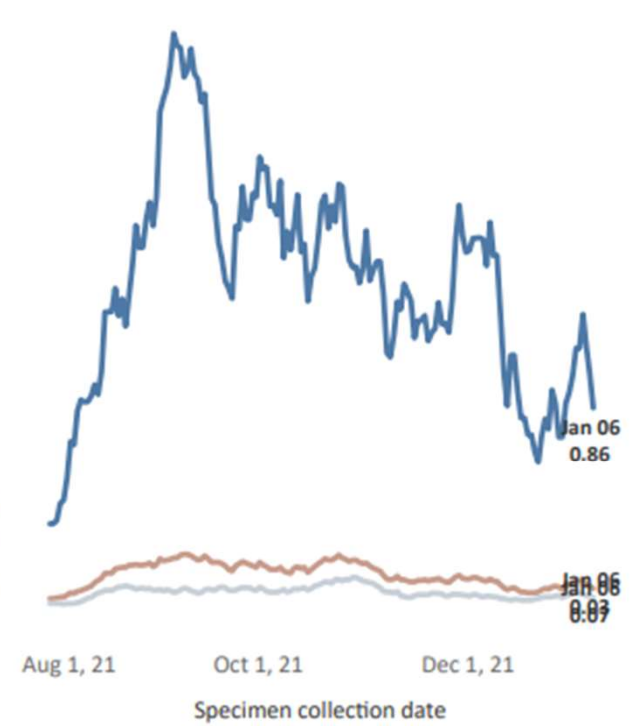

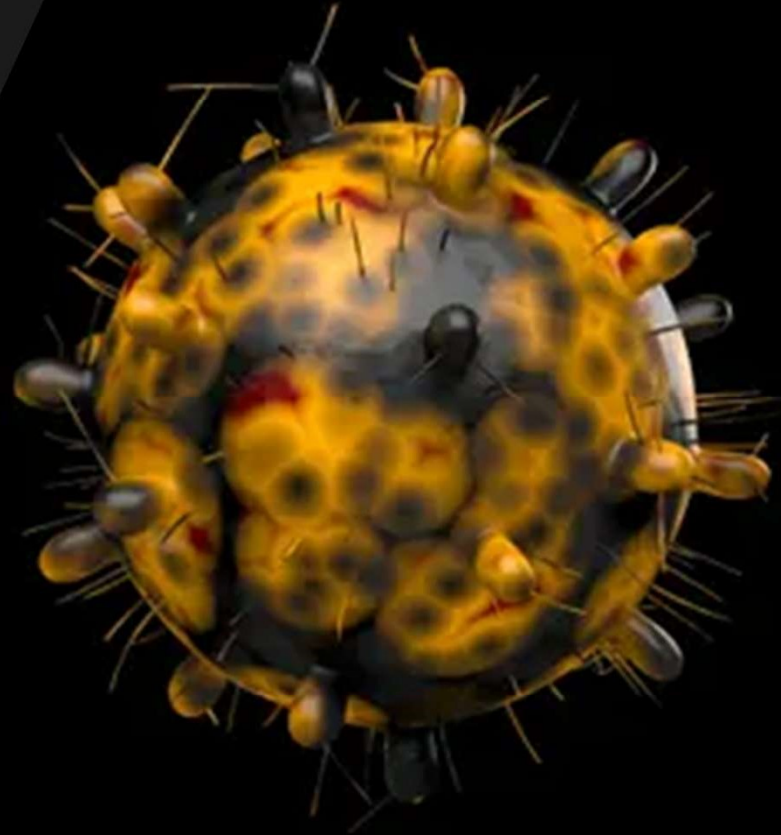

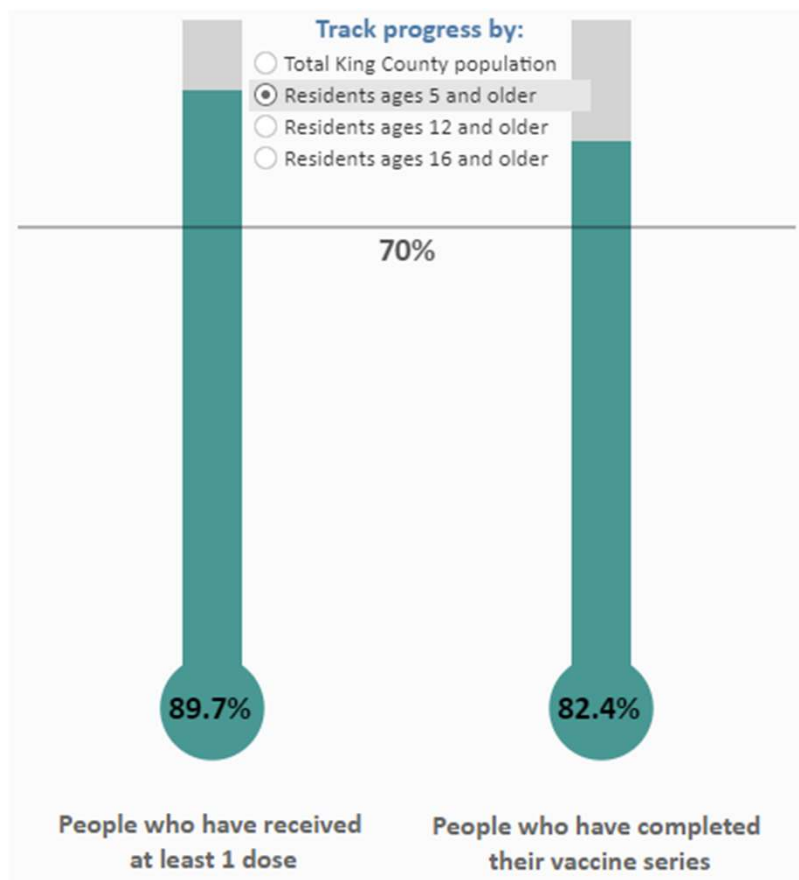

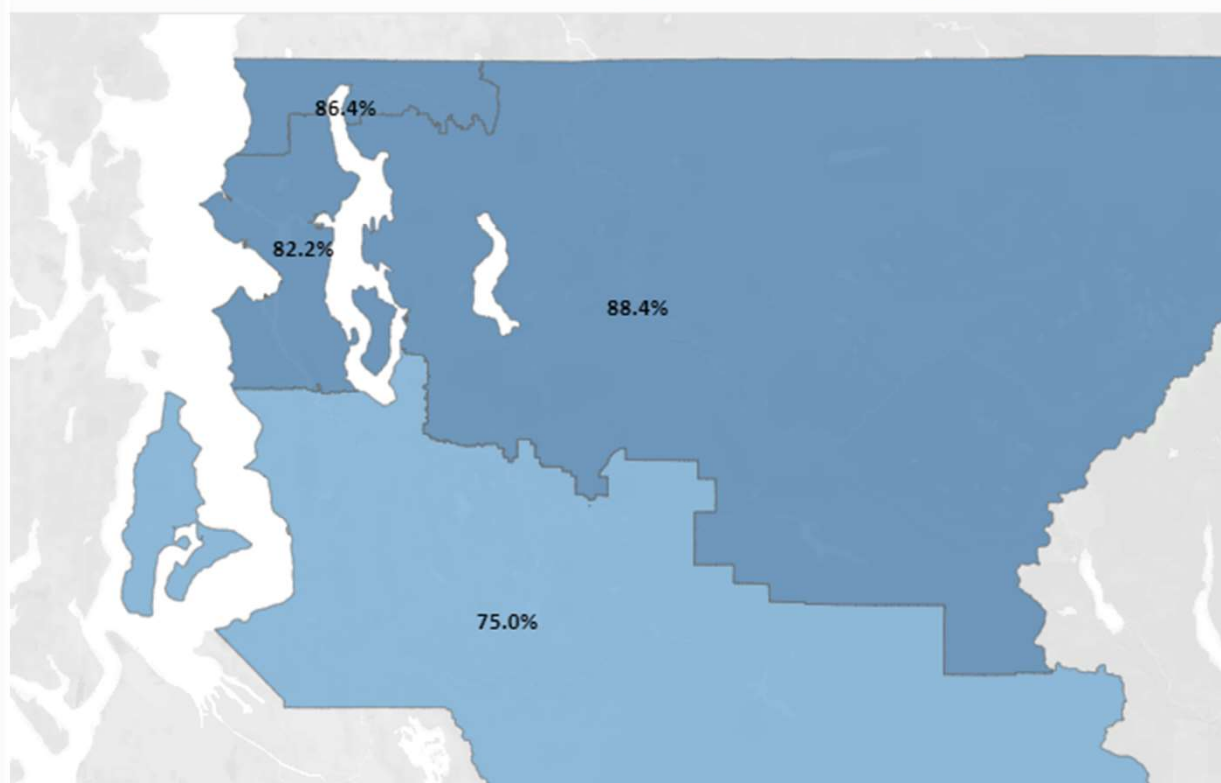
