

Over the last week, there has been an **increasing** trend of case counts (n=32,301) by **87.9%** compared to the previous week (n=17,188)









Summary of COVID-19 hospitalizations Monday, January 10, 2022


Over the last week, there has been an increasing trend of hospitalizations (n=366) by 110.3% compared to the previous week (n=174)

Daily hospital admissions among PCR positive cases in King County, WA






