Seattle is a thriving equitable community powered by dependable transportation. We're on a mission to deliver a transportation system that provides safe and affordable access to places and opportunities.






## East Marginal Way Corridor Improvement Project

East Marginal Way is a major freight corridor, designated heavy haul route, critical last-mile connector and vital route for over-sized trucks or those carrying flammable cargo.

It is also a major connection for people who bike between the West Seattle Bridge Trail, downtown, and the SODO neighborhood.

## East Marginal Way Corridor Improvement Project

**Grant Award:** \$20 million RAISE grant

Local Match: \$33.9 million

Port of Seattle Contribution: \$5.5 million

**Project Impact**: Improvements to the corridor

include:

- Reconstruct roadway to meet heavy haul network standards along 1.1-mile segment
- Construct 2-way protected bike lane along 1.4-mile segment
- Rebuild a portion of the sidewalk
- Construct new traffic signals to enhance safety







## Sidewalk Improvements on 4<sup>th</sup> Ave S

**Grant Award:** \$247,000

Transportation Improvement

**Local Match:** \$130,016

**Project Impact**: Project

constructs a new sidewalk on 4<sup>th</sup> Ave S near the I-90 to provide a seamless walkway between downtown, the stadium district, and numerous bus stops along the corridor.
