Montlake Playfield Use

- Main Sports Scheduled: Lacrosse, football, Ultimate Frisbee, field hockey
- Pre-2011 Grass Playfield Use: Available June 1 –
 Oct. 21 (5 months per year)

*Normal grass field available: March 1 – Nov. 22 (9 months)

- 2012-Present Synthetic Field Use: Available Jan. 1
- Dec. 31 (12 months per year)





SPR/Seattle Prep Partnership History

- ► Pre-2011: Montlake Playfield was a grass football field. It was often muddy due to high use and marsh-like field conditions.
- ▶ 2011: Memorandum of Understanding signed between Seattle Parks and Recreation and Seattle Preparatory School to install synthetic turf at Montlake Playfield.
- 2012: Synthetic turf donated by the University of Washington.
- ▶ 2012-Present: Seattle Prep has been a valued partner, using Montlake for football and lacrosse practices and some games through its agreement with SPR.

Proposed Legislation – Key Terms

- Authorizes Superintendent of Parks and Recreation to enter into a 12-year agreement with Seattle Prep -- extension of existing agreement
- Seattle Prep will pay for all costs related to the planning, design, and construction of a new synthetic athletic field (to replace worn-out turf) at Montlake Park
- Seattle Prep will continue to pay field use fees and be given scheduling priority (see subsequent slide)
- Seattle Prep commits to annual public benefits (see subsequent slide)



Conditions of Proposed Agreement

- **Term:** 12 years with an option for one 12-year extension
- **Construction:** Seattle Prep will be responsible for all costs related to construction of the project.
- **Use Fee**: Seattle Prep will pay for all use of the playfield at the rate set by the City.
- Maintenance: The City will be responsible for all minor and major maintenance and utility costs to operate facility.
- Ownership: The City will remain the owner of the field









Seattle Prep Authorized Use

Seattle Prep will have priority access during the following dates and times:

- Maximum of 100 hours during June, July and August
- March 1 June 15: 3:00 p.m. to 5:30 p.m.,
 M F, 9:00 a.m. to 12:00 pm, Saturdays
- Aug. 10 Nov. 30: 3:00 to 5:30 p.m., M F, 9:00 a.m. to 12:00 p.m., Saturdays
- Football Games: Limited to 4 junior varsity football games and 4 freshmen football games per season.







Proposed Annual Public Benefit

Public Benefits	Description
Public Service	Seattle Prep shall provide a minimum of 50 public service hours annually
Volunteer Service	Seattle Prep shall provide a Public Service Report that summarizes public service hours provided during the previous calendar year.
Community Outreach & Events	 Outreach to underserved communities through the creations of; Lacrosse programs for middle school-aged children from low-income families Partnering w/Montlake CC to provide tutoring services by Seattle Prep students for children of low-income & marginalized backgrounds Assisting Northwest Child, a program dedicated to supporting the disability community with recreation opportunities.
Programs	Identify & conduct programming in collaboration with: • Montlake CC • Local schools • Nonprofit organizations
