PILOT AGREEMENT (2020 - 2022)

1 Pier 62 and Floating Dock
Rebuilt to once again to support free public concerts and events.

MANAGEMENT AGREEMENT (2023)

- 1 Pier 62 and Floating Dock
- 2 Alaskan Way East and Union Street
 Widened sidewalk, landscaping and green storm-water features. A new
 pedestrian bridge and elevator at Union Street will connect Western Avenue
 to the Waterfront Promenade.
- Waterfront Promenade A few linear park with walkways, lighting, landscaping, seating and green storm-water features. In Elliott Bay, new underwater habitat improvements will help restore the native inter-tidal habitat.
- 4 Habitat Bench and Washington Street Boat Landing Restored landmark pergola structure that will serve the public through small concessions and a new public beach that supports the ecosystem, including the salmon corridor.
- 5 Railroad Way A pedestrian gateway linking the waterfront to Pioneer Square and the stadiums. Railroad Way will encourage new circulation and activities throughout the year and on game days at Lumen Field and Safeco Field.

Pier 58 Rebuilt park with an urban plaza and children's playground.

7 Overlook Walk

A new, accessible connection between Pike Place Market and the Waterfront. It will take pedestrians over the new Alaskan Way without crossing the street and will include seating, informal play areas and views.
