Property tax overview: Three types of property tax levies

1. General Purpose Levy

- Not subject to voter approval
- Growth is limited to 1% + value of new construction

2. Voter-Approved Levies for Specific Purposes

- Known as levy "lid lifts" because voters authorize taxation above the statutory lid
- Examples: Move Seattle, Housing, Families, Education, Preschool and Promise, Election Vouchers, Libraries for All
- Requires 50% +1 majority

3. Levy to Pay Debt Service on Voter-Approved Bonds

- Known as an "excess levy" because it does not count against the City's rate limit
- Examples: 2012 Alaskan Way Seawall and 1998 Library Facilities bond measures
- Requires 60% supermajority

Calculating the property tax

Calculating the tax rate for the City:

Annual Levy Collection Amount = Tax Rate

(Total Assessed Value (AV) of All Property / \$1,000)

Calculating the tax amount for an individual property:

Tax Rate x (AV / \$1,000) = Annual Property Tax Amount





2022 AMOUNT BY JURISDICTION FOR MEDIAN AV HOME (\$760,000)





Components of City's Property Tax Levy for 2022





Property tax exemptions and deferrals


WA State offers four property tax exemption or deferral program for primary residences:

Program	Income Level	Other Eligibility Requirements
Property Tax Exemption	Greater of \$40,000 or 65% of the county median household income	 At least 61 years of age, OR Disabled and unable to pursue gainful employment, OR Veteran receiving compensation at total disability rating, OR Surviving spouse or domestic partner at least 57 years or older in the year of death
Deferral for Senior Citizens and People with Disabilities	Greater of \$45,000 or 75% of county median household income	 At least 60 years of age, OR Disabled and unable to pursue gainful employment, OR Surviving spouse or domestic partner at least 57 years or older in the year of death
Deferral for Homeowners with Limited Income	≤\$57,000	- Must have owned for 5 years – "in fee" or by contract purchase
Widow or Widower of Qualifying Veteran	≤\$40,000	- At least 61 years of age, OR - Disabled and unable to pursue gainful employment

Where do our senior citizens' property taxes go?


SENIOR AMOUNT BY JURISDICTION FOR MEDIAN AV HOME (\$760,000)

Levy Scenarios: Considerations

- 1. Total City rate is capped at \$3.60/\$1,000 AV
 - Combined total of regular rate, plus lid lifts cannot exceed this rate
 - Excess levy (bonds) not included under cap
- 2. Sequencing and size of lid lifts
 - Timing and size of City lifts, and those of other jurisdictions, can 'crowd out' taxpayer appetite for future lifts
 - All City lid lifts (low-income housing, transportation, etc.)
 - Key County levy lid lifts Veterans, Best Start, Parks
 - School District levy lid lifts
 - Potential new County levy for behavioral health April 2023 vote

Levy Scenarios: Assumptions


- 1. Based on AV growth estimates from Office of Economic and Revenue Forecasts
- 2. Three scenarios modeled for illustrative purposes:
 - Inflation: adjusts for inflation
 - 100% Increase: Doubling of all City lid lifts at renewal date
 - 200% Increase: Tripling of all City lid lifts at renewal date

City lid lift renewal amounts by scenario (\$millions)



Families, Education, Preschool & Promise (FEPP)	\$620	\$872	\$1,277	\$1,916
Transportation	\$930	\$1,353	\$1,934	\$2,901
Library	\$213	\$312	\$452	\$677
Election Vouchers	\$30	\$38	\$60	\$90

^{*}Scenarios also include the impact of the annual 1% growth levy growth permitted by state law, which marginally increases the calculated amounts for some levies above the stated scenario level.


City tax burden median AV home




Overall tax burden, median AV home




Levy revenue compared to capacity, by scenario




City Comparison: 2022 Median Residential Property Values
