4 5 6 7	AN ORDINANCE relating to the City's criminal code; amending elements and defenses of property destruction; and amending Section 12A.08.020 of the Seattle Municipal Code.
8	WHEREAS, graffiti remains a significant public nuisance that the City devotes millions of
9	taxpayer dollars to combat, including the Clean City Initiative; and
10	WHEREAS, amending SMC 12A.08.020 to more closely align with RCW 9A.48.090 furthers
11	the City's efforts to combat the negative effects of graffiti on the public health, safety,
12	and welfare. Now, therefore,
13	BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY OF SEATTLE AS FOLLOWS:
14	Section 1. Section 12A.08.020 of the Seattle Municipal Code, last amended by Ordinance
15	123191, is amended as follows:
16	12A.08.020 Property destruction
17	A. A person is guilty of property destruction if ((he or she)) the person intentionally:
18	1. ((Intentionally damages)) Damages the property of another; or
19	2. Writes, paints, or draws any inscription, figure, or mark of any type on any
20	public or private building or other structure or any real or personal property owned by any other
21	person unless the person has obtained the express permission of the owner or operator of the
22	property.
23	B. 1. It is an affirmative defense to property destruction under subsection 12A.08.020.A.1
24	that the actor reasonably believed that he had a lawful right to damage such property.

1	((2. It is an affirmative defense to property destruction under subsection 12A.08.020.A.2
2	that the actor had obtained express permission of the owner or operator of the building, structure,
3	or property.))
4	C. Property destruction is a gross misdemeanor.

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1	Section 2. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force 30 days after its approval by
2	the Mayor, but if not approved and returned by the Mayor within ten days after presentation, it
3	shall take effect as provided by Seattle Municipal Code Section 1.04.020.
