Amendment 1, Version 2, to CB 120549 – Relating to crime of Obstructing a Public Officer to include obstructing firefighters and fire department personnel.

Quarterly Reporting of Demographics

Effect: This amendment would require for one year the quarterly reporting of demographic information collected for individuals who are <u>arrested</u> receive citations under SMC 12A.16.010, as amended.

On page 3, after subsection D, add a new section as follows:

Section 2. The Seattle Police Department shall report for one year to the City Council on the locations, disposition, and demographic information of individuals arrested receiving citations issued under Seattle Municipal Code Section 12A.16.010, when arrested the citation is issued for obstructing fire department personnel in the performance of their official duties or when obstruction occurs at the scene of a fire department emergency response pursuant to subsection 12A.16.010.A.6. Reporting shall occur on at least a quarterly basis to the Chair and membership of the committee with oversight of public safety, beginning no later than September 2023.

Renumber the remaining section(s) accordingly.
