Amendment #2 to RES 32093 - Relating to Low-Income Housing Sponsors: Councilmember Morales, Herbold, and Mosqueda

Amend Section 3 (B) as follows:

B. OH will continue work with community partners and affordable housing developers to explore how housing investments can support\_broader community development goals including but not limited to <a href="mailto:ehild-care">ehild-care</a>, health services, affordable commercial space, for uses necessary to meet residents' everyday needs such as commercial or non-profit groceries, childcare, health services, fresh, healthy food merchants, home goods, cultural anchors, and other desired community services. OH is requested to work with the Office of Economic Development (OED), the Office of Planning and Community Development (OPCD), and Department of Early Learning and Education (DEEL) to facilitate and coordinate different funding sources and requirements of such mixed-use projects.

**Effect:** Add additional specific examples of community development goals, including commercial or non-profit groceries, home goods, and cultural anchors.
