Payment of the sum of \$55,563,761.17 on City General Salary Fund 17 mechanical warrants numbered 51381867 – 51382524 plus manual warrants, agencies warrants, 18 and direct deposits numbered 180001 – 182888 representing Gross Payrolls for payroll ending 19 date April 25, 2023, as detailed in the Payroll Summary Report for claims against the City that 20 were reported to the City Council May 04, 2023, is approved consistent with remaining 21 appropriations in the current budget as amended. 22 Section 3.
