

Dual Dispatch Objectives

Excerpt from Term Sheet: Alternative 911 Response, 09/11/2022

- Diversifies the City's emergency response options to better meet the community's need including non-law enforcement response
- Reduces harm and provides an equitable system of emergency response
- Preserves first-responder capacity for appropriate emergency responses
- Increases rate of response and timeliness of responses to Priority 3 and Priority 4 calls

Work Updates: Capital and Equipment

- SMT 500 procured for workspace
- Equipment procured:
 - (5) Portable Radios APX 6000
 - (1) Bank Charger
 - (2) Desk Chargers
 - (4) Spare Batteries
 - (2) Mobile Radios Pending vehicle install
 - (1) Base Station Radio / Consolette Pending office space allocation
 - (1) Base Station / Consolette Antenna Hookup Pending office space allocation
 - (7) Responder laptops and (7) mobile phones to be procured July 2023

Vehicles

- (1) Ford Explorer procured, repurposed from FAS
- (2) In process from SFD (Fall 2023)



Work Updates: Responder Hiring and Training

- 3 Communications Officer finalists identified (July hire)
- Responder positions submitted via supplemental budget
- Responder job descriptions drafted and in city approval process (Aug 2023)
- 15-module training in development with UW School of Social Work (Aug 2023)
- Language coordination and protocol standardization between 911/SFD/SPD (Aug 2023)

Work Updates: Operations

- CAD protocol creation (July 2023)
- Call type coordination with SPD/SFD complete: Priority 3 and Priority 4 Person Down and Welfare Check
- 911 Operator training (Aug 2023)
 - Ongoing updates shared via roll calls
- Field testing (Aug-Sep 2023)
- Pilot staffing schedule finalized (Aug 2023)

Work Updates: Evaluation

- Evaluation being designed with Seattle University (Aug 2023)
 - Identifying key metrics and leading indicators of success (national survey of leading pilots)
- Dashboard in development with Dept of Performance & Innovation (Aug 2023)
- Workgroup with SPD CRT and SFD Health One: scheduling weekly after action review meetings for first 90 days

Work Updates: Collaboration & Community Engagement

- Common core crisis training in development with SPD, SFD, DHS
- Case management software potentially extended to SPD Crisis Response Team and CSCC/CARE responders for improved coordination
- Community engagement in development with Dept of Neighborhoods to drive awareness and build feedback loop
- Strengthening coordination: King County Behavioral Health, WA State CRIS, 988/Crisis Connections, national resources
