3 4 5 6 7	A RESOLUTION calling upon the National Highway Traffic Safety Administration to issue a recall of Kia and Hyundai models lacking immobilizer technology that are vulnerable to theft.
8	WHEREAS, in January 2023, The City of Seattle was the first municipality in the nation to file a
9	complaint against automakers Kia and Hyundai, seeking the manufacturers be required to
10	install industry standard anti-theft technology in specific Kia and Hyundai models made
11	between 2011 and 2021; and to recover damages for the City from the automakers, as the
12	absence of the technology led to an extraordinary number of vehicle thefts and a
13	commensurate surge in response by Seattle Police; and
14	WHEREAS, Kia and Hyundai did not install industry-standard engine immobilizer technology
15	on certain models between 2011 and 2022; and
16	WHEREAS, vehicles with this vulnerability can be easily stolen using a universal serial bus
17	(USB) cable and screwdriver in minutes, and instructional videos on how to do so have spread
18	widely on TikTok and other social media platforms; and
19	WHEREAS, this vulnerability has allowed youth under the age of 16 and unlicensed drivers to
20	access Kia and Hyundai vehicles and drive recklessly; and
21	WHEREAS, earlier this year, Kia and Hyundai offered free software updates to address this
22	vulnerability; however, not all impacted vehicles are able to receive these software
23	upgrades; and
24	WHEREAS, unlike voluntary software upgrades, a recall includes mailed notification to all
25	impacted vehicle owners and the opportunity for a dealer to buy back a vehicle that
26	cannot be repaired; and

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1	WHEREAS, in Seattle, between January 1, 2020 and October 31, 2023, 1,889 Kias and
2	Hyundais were stolen and The City of Seattle wants to join cities like Philadelphia and
3	Baltimore in calling for a recall; NOW, THEREFORE,
4	BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SEATTLE THAT:
5	Section 1. The City Council calls on the National Highway Traffic Safety Administration
6	(NHTSA) to issue a recall of Kia and Hyundai models lacking immobilizer technology that are
7	vulnerable to theft.
8	Section 2. The City Council requests the Office of Intergovernmental Relations to convey
9	to Seattle's Congressional delegation its support for efforts to call on the NHTSA to issue a
10	recall of Kia and Hyundai models lacking immobilizer technology that are vulnerable to theft.
