# Budget & Revenue

- HB 2219 (Hackney) - Establishes a sales and use tax exemption for the construction and maintenance of affordable housing by nonprofits (City signed in support)
- SB 6249 (Robinson) - Authorizes a state property tax exemption equal to the greater of \$100,000 or 60 percent of the county median home value.
- HB 2348 (Street) - Authorizes counties that establish hospitals to use county money, levy taxes, and issue bonds to pay, finance, or refinance capital expenses related to the hospital. Expands the uses for which the county tax may be used to include the operation of the county hospital, capital expenses, and for payment of principal and interest on bonds issued for those purposes (City signed in support)



# Climate & Environment

- SB 5973 (Lias) - Prohibits common interest communities from adopting restrictions that effectively prohibit or unreasonably restrict the installation or use of heat pumps by unit owners (City signed in support)
- HB 2401 (Duerr) - Requires producers of bulk refrigerants and precharged appliances to participate in and implement a refrigerant gas stewardship program (City signed in support)
- SB 6180 (Lovick)/HB 2301 (Doglio) - Improving outcomes associated with waste material management systems, including products affecting organic material management systems (City signed in support)
- SB 6256 (Stanford) - Requires a licensed electrical contractor to advertise, offer to work on, bid, engage in, conduct, or carry on the business of installing, repairing, replacing, or maintaining solar energy systems that cost more than \$1,000. Requires all solar energy installation contracts to include various provisions, notices, and disclosures (City signed in support)
- SB 6276 (Stanford) - Establishes the Right to Repair Act which requires manufacturers of digital electronic products to make available to independent repair providers certain parts, tools, and documentation on fair and reasonable terms for the diagnosis, maintenance, and repair of digital electronic products (City signed in support)



# General Government

- SB 6231 (Lovelett) – Prohibits cities, towns, code cities, and counties from installing or constructing hostile architecture elements to restrict the use of any public space by people experiencing homelessness.
- SB 5993 (Hasegawa) – Requires a voting jurisdiction to create a public education campaign whenever a voting jurisdiction changes its method of candidate selection from the methods described in state law. Establishes a cause of action to allow a voter to enforce the public education campaign requirements (City signed in as "other")
- HB 2250 (Gregerson) – Permits the use of ranked choice voting in elections for offices in counties, cities, towns, school districts, fire districts, and port districts, and establishes certain requirements for RCV ballot design and vote tabulation.





# Healthcare & Behavioral Health

- SB 6228 (Dhingra) – Related to substance use disorder (City signed in support)
  - Insurance provisions: Requires health plans to authorize up to 28 days of inpatient or residential SUD treatment on the first utilization review. Requires health plans to cover ground ambulance transportation to and from behavioral health emergency services provider when a person is experiencing an emergency medical condition as an alternative to an emergency room, and to also cover transportation upon discharge.
  - Workforce provisions: Caps certification fees for substance use disorder professionals and trainees at \$100 until July 1, 2029. Removes limitations on license and certification renewals for associate marriage and family therapists, associate mental health counselors, associate social workers, and SUDP trainees.
- SB 2247 (Bateman) – Changes licensing requirements, practice settings, and reimbursement requirements for various behavioral health professions (City signed in support)
- HB 2469 (Davis) – Revises provisions of the Involuntary Treatment Act to require courts to consult the Judicial Information System before entering relief, expand eligible petitioners under Joel's Law, address determinations regarding whether a person will seek voluntary treatment, and address required notices of loss of firearm rights (City signed in support)



# Housing & Homelessness

- HB 2308 (Walen)/SB 6175 (Trudeau) - Authorizes city governing authorities to establish a property tax exemption program for properties which are converted into buildings that contain affordable housing units for low-income households (City signed in support)
- HB 2252 – Requires cities and towns to allow neighborhood cafes that meet certain requirements to be permitted in residential zones (City signed in "other")
- HB 2270 (Morgan) – Directs the Office of Financial Management to contract for a study to help facilitate the transition of state housing programs to a new state agency and identify gaps in current state housing programs.



# Labor & Commerce

- SB 6220 (Salomon) – Increases the minimum legal age of sale of cannabis products with a THC concentration greater than 35 percent, to be age 25, with an exception for qualifying patients and designated providers.
- SB 6271 (Keiser) – Requires LCB to formulate a recommended approach and implementation plan for modifying the cannabis excise tax to allow for tax rates based on THC concentration.
- HB 2362 (Chambers) – Creates a new endorsement to the brewery and winery licenses authorizing off-site and pop-up retail sales, service, and consumption of beer or wine, for on-premises and off-premises consumption (City signed in support)
- HB 2266 (Stonier) – Requires the Department of Labor and Industries to adopt rules applicable to the construction industry that require employers to provide reasonable accommodations for employees who menstruate or express milk (City signed in support)



# Public Safety & Criminal Justice

- SB 6009 (Trudeau) - Prohibits peace officers from hog-tying a person or assisting in putting a person into a hog-tie (City signed in support)
- SB 6242 (Mullet) - Removes the requirement that law enforcement agencies reimburse the Criminal Justice Training Commission for 25 percent of the costs of training (City signed in support)
- HB 2311 (Davis) - Requires the CJTC to develop a first responder peer support counselor training program, administer a grant program to implement a first responder peer support counselor program, and requires CJTC to provide grants to local law enforcement for officer wellness programs (City signed in support)
- HB 2088 (Orwall) - Extending liability protections for responders dispatched from mobile rapid response crisis teams and community-based crisis teams (City testified in support)
- SB 6157 (Lovick) - Permits DACA recipients to apply for civil service positions as city firefighters, city police, fish and wildlife officers, peace and corrections officers, and for positions within the sheriff's office (City signed in support)





# Social Programs & Education

- HB 2309 (Bergquist) - Creates the Washington 13 Free Guarantee to provide up to 45 credits of tuition free community or technical college to eligible students regardless of income (City signed in support)
- HB 2374 (Pollet) - Creates the Washington Promise Program to provide up to 90 credits of tuition-free community or technical college to eligible students (City signed in support)
- SB 6300 (Randall) - Expands demonstration of financial need for Washington College Grant eligibility to include students who participate in Washington's Basic Food Program, the Food Assistance Program, or Apple Health for Kids. (City signed in support)
- HB 2368 (Gregerson) - Requires the DSHS to coordinate state, federal, and local efforts to support the economic and social integration of immigrants and refugees arriving and resettling in Washington. Authorizes DSHS to administer services to immigrants who are ineligible for federally funded services (City signed in support)
- SB 6216 (Nobles) - Directs the OSPI to provide state-level coordination to help schools better identify and connect students to behavioral health supports. Establishes a regional school-based mental and behavioral health student assistance program through the educational service districts (City signed in support)
