Budget & Revenue

- HB 2428 (Klicker) - Allows cities and towns to enter into interlocal agreements to share a portion of general purpose local government sales and use tax revenue.
- HB 2354 (Street) - Creating an option for impacted taxing districts to provide a portion of their new revenue to support any tax increment area proposed within their jurisdiction.



Climate & Environment

- SHB 1012 (Leavitt) - Develop and implement an Extreme Weather Response Grant Program for the purpose of assisting with the costs of responding to community needs during periods of extremely hot or cold weather, or severe poor air quality due to wildfire smoke. (City signed in support)
- SHB 2144 (Stonier) - Authorizing a beverage deposit return program. (City signed in support)
- ESHB 1589 (Doglio) - Ban any gas company that serves more than 500,000 customers (specifically, Puget Sound Energy) from connecting new natural gas lines to new residential or commercial buildings. Hearing was on a substitute version.
- HB 2049 (Berry) - Improving Washington's solid waste management outcomes (City signed in support)



General Government

- HB 2455 (Gregerson) - Permits local governments to use a different voting process as part of the ballot title for competing ballot measures—initiatives to the local government versus alternative measures proposed by the local government—than the voting process used for competing statewide ballot measures.
- SB 5957 (Boehnke) - Directs the Consolidated Technology Services agency to develop guidelines for the use of artificial intelligence.



Healthcare & Behavioral Health

- SB 5986 (Cleveland) - Establishes balance billing protections for certain ground ambulance services. Requires health carriers to provide coverage for ground ambulance transport services to behavioral health emergency services providers for enrollees who are experiencing an emergency medical condition (City signed in support)
- SB 5906 (Wilson, L) - Requires the Department of Health to develop and maintain an ongoing drug overdose prevention campaign (City signed in support)

Housing & Homelessness

- HB 2474 (Peterson) - Concerning compliance with siting requirements for transitional housing, permanent supportive housing, indoor emergency shelters, and indoor emergency housing.
- HB 1054 (Walen) - Prohibits an association of unit owners in a common interest community from regulating or limiting the number of unrelated persons that may occupy a unit.



Labor & Commerce

- SB 6074 (Saldaña) - Provides that death benefits under the workers' compensation system must be paid to a transportation network company (TNC) driver if the driver's death results from an injury while the driver was logged onto the TNC's digital network as available for work and physically inside or within the immediate proximity of the TNC driver's vehicle (City signed in support)
- SB 6107 (Cleveland) - Requires the Department of Labor and Industries to adopt rules to address safety and health issues for construction workers who menstruate or express milk, including requiring employers to provide reasonable accommodations for the workers (City signed in support)



Public Safety & Criminal Justice

- HB 1530 (Cortes) - Permits law enforcement agencies to consider applicants who are United States citizens or lawful permanent residents for any office, place, position, or employment within the agency. (City signed in support)
- HB 1062 (Peterson) - Concerning deception by law enforcement officers during custodial interrogations.
- HB 2153 (Ryu) - Deterring the theft of catalytic converters.



Social Programs & Education

- HB 2415 (Cortes) - Increases the maximum amount of TANF Diversion Cash Assistance that eligible individuals can receive from \$1,500 to \$2,000. (City signed in support)
- HB 1916 (Senn) - Concerning funding for the early support for infants and toddlers program. (City signed in support)
- HB 2019 (Stearns) - Establishing a Native American apprentice assistance program. (City signed in support)
- HB 2214 (Slatter) - Permitting beneficiaries of public assistance programs to automatically qualify as income-eligible for the purpose of receiving the Washington college grant. (City signed in support)



Transportation

- SB 5594 (Boehnke) - Authorizes the operation of autonomous motor vehicles on public roadways, subject to certain requirements (City signed in as "other")
- SB 5872 (Lovick) - Requires a human safety operator to be physically present inside an autonomous vehicle (AV) when in operation to monitor performance and intervene if necessary.
