# CB 120752 - Grant Acceptance & Appropriation

---

- First comprehensive grant acceptance and appropriation in 2024
- Would authorize departments to accept \$10.5 million and appropriate \$7.8 million from external sources
- \$7.2 million (70 percent) are SPU environmental grants for:
  - \$4 million from EPA to support local circular wood economy
  - \$2 million RCO grant for Cedar River riverine restoration
  - \$1.3 million from KC Flood Control District for Duwamish and Taylor Creek improvements
