

Amendment 4 Version 2 to CB 120844 – SPD Closed-Circuit Television Camera Systems SIR ORD

Sponsor: Councilmember Saka

Study of additional CCTV sites and scope

Effect: This amendment directs the Seattle Police Department, as part of the planned evaluation of the Closed-Circuit Television (CCTV) Systems pilot, to study the appropriateness, feasibility, and cost of future potential CCTV camera deployments in other areas of the city including the Alki and Harbor Avenue areas of West Seattle, as well as potential use for additional public safety concerns including unlawful racing.

Add a new Section 3 to CB 120844 as follows and renumber subsequent sections as appropriate:

Section 3. The Seattle Police Department shall, as part of the planned outcome evaluation of the Closed-Circuit Television Camera Systems pilot project, conduct a study reporting on the appropriateness, feasibility, and cost of additional potential future Closed-Circuit Television Camera deployments in areas of the city beyond those in the current pilot project, including but not limited to the Alki and Harbor Avenue areas of West Seattle. This study shall also evaluate the potential use of Closed-Circuit Television Cameras for a range of public safety concerns beyond those specific crimes identified in the SIR for purposes of the pilot project, including but not limited to unlawful racing and related community safety challenges.
