

2024 State Legislative Session Council Briefing

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State Updates

- Governor Inslee Proposed Budget
 - \$12 billion shortfall over four years
 - \$2 billion in cuts via reductions or delays
 - Proposes wealth tax (\$10b) and B&O changes (\$2.6b)
- Governor-Elect Ferguson Budget Priorities
 - Additional \$4 billion in cuts (no reduction to basic education, public safety agencies)
 - No revenue proposals
 - \$800 million in new spending:
 - \$100 million grant program for law enforcement recruitment
 - \$5 million to clear backlog of cases at WA Toxicology Lab
 - \$240 million for universal free school meals
 - \$20 million for ferry service and staff recruitment
 - \$600 million in capital budget funds for housing
- Changes in Seattle Delegation

Seattle Priorities Update

- Public Safety
 - SB 5098 (Valdez) - Weapons in certain locations
 - HB 1112 (Farivar) - SMC pro tempore judges/residency
 - HB 1228 (Hackney) - Toxicology testing by certified or accredited labs
 - Needs improvement - Gov. Inslee's budget proposal reduces funding for basic law enforcement training from funding 33 classes to funding a total of 25 classes. Reimposes a 25% cost shift back to local governments for training new recruits.
 - SB 5052 (Salomon) - Law enforcement/juvenile contact
 - In progress – pedestrian safe systems legislation



Seattle Priorities Update

- Public & Behavioral Health
 - In progress – ITA legislation (Davis)
 - SB 5126 (Nobles)/OSPI request legislation - establishing statewide network for student mental and behavioral health
- Economic Development & Small Business
 - In progress – Updating outdoor dining and Seattle Center alcohol regulations
 - Supporting 2026 World Cup funding asks
- Housing & Homelessness
 - \$25 million in Gov budget for asylum seekers
 - \$38 million in Gov budget for encampment resolutions on state rights-of-way
 - In progress – condo liability bill (Taylor)
 - \$600 million in Governor's capital budget for housing
 - Working with Rep. Macri, King County, KCRHA, & homelessness providers on a joint homelessness budget ask to fund critical homeless services and prevent closure of shelters who are losing one-time federal funds provided by City of Seattle/King County
