Amendments to Council Bill 118310 v11 – Transitional Encampment as Interim Use Environmental review and threshold determination for proposal without restriction by zone or ownership Sponsor: Sawant

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The proposed amendment would state Council's request that Department of Planning and Development (DPD) complete environmental review and make a threshold determination on a proposal that would allow the City of Seattle to issue Type I Master Use Permits for transitional encampments as an interim use without restriction by zone or property ownership.

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Section 11. The City Council requests that the Department of Planning and Development (DPD) complete environmental review and make a threshold determination according to Chapter 25.05 SMC on a proposal to modify the new Section 23.42.056 of the Seattle Municipal Code as proposed in this ordinance that would allow the City of Seattle to issue Type I Master Use Permits for transitional encampments as an interim use without restriction by zone or property ownership. The Council requests that DPD complete the environmental review and make a threshold determination, and attempt to report back to the Planning, Land Use and Sustainability Committee no later than August 31, 2015.

Section 1112. Severability. The provisions of this ordinance are declared to be separate and severable. The invalidity of any clause, sentence, paragraph, sub-division, section or portion of this ordinance, or the invalidity of the application thereof to any person or circumstance shall not affect the validity of the remainder of this ordinance, or the validity of its application to other persons or circumstances.

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
