**1. BILL SUMMARY**

**Legislation Title:**

AN ORDINANCE relating to Seattle Public Utilities; authorizing the Director of Seattle Public Utilities to accept the grant of a non-exclusive easement within the West Waterway of the Duwamish River from the Washington State Department of Natural Resources for a City-owned sanitary sewer line.

**Summary and background of the Legislation:**

In 2009, a critical Seattle Public Utilities sewer main in the Duwamish River West Waterway was ruptured by a pile driving operation. SPU installed a new line immediately south of the original crossing, necessitating a new easement. This legislation would authorize the Director of SPU to accept that easement from the Washington Department of Natural Resources.
