1. BILL SUMMARY

Legislation Title: AN ORDINANCE approving and confirming the plat of "Valentine Homes" in the portions of Northwest ¹/₄ of Section 9, Township 24 North, Range 4 East, W.M. in King County, Washington.

Summary and background of the Legislation:

This legislation approves a 13-unit unit lot subdivision at 1756 Valentine Place S. The Hearing Examiner held a public hearing on June 18, 2014, and issued her approval of the preliminary plat of the unit lot subdivision on June 25, 2014, subject to City Council approval.

This unit lot subdivision divides a parent lot into 13 unit lots. This unit lot subdivision is consistent with the area zoning, which is Lowrise2.
