1. BILL SUMMARY

Legislation Title:

AN ORDINANCE relating to historic preservation; imposing controls upon the Pacific Science Center, a landmark designated by the Landmarks Preservation Board under Chapter 25.12 of the Seattle Municipal Code, and adding it to the Table of Historical Landmarks contained in Chapter 25.32 of the Seattle Municipal Code.

Summary and background of the Legislation:

The attached legislation acknowledges the designation of the Pacific Science Center as a historic landmark by the Landmarks Preservation Board, imposes controls, grants incentives, and adds the Pacific Science Center to the Table of Historical Landmarks contained in SMC Chapter 25.32. The legislation does not have a financial impact.

The Pacific Science Center was built in 1962, and is located in the Lower Queen Anne neighborhood. A Controls and Incentives Agreement has been signed by the owner and has been approved by the Landmarks Preservation Board. The controls in the agreement apply to the site; specified site elements; the exteriors of most of the buildings; the hemispherical projection dome and screen of the Laser Dome Theater; and the original curved walls within the Paccar Theater; but do not apply to any in–kind maintenance or repairs of the designated features.
