1. BILL SUMMARY

Legislation Title: A RESOLUTION opposing Washington Initiative Measure 1366 and urging Seattle voters to vote "no" on Initiative 1366 on the November 3, 2015 general election ballot.

Summary and background of the Legislation: This legislation states the City Council and Mayor's opposition to Initiative 1366 (I-1366). I-1366 would cut the Washington State sales tax from 6.5% to 5.5%, resulting in a loss of over eight billion dollars in revenue over the next six years. This would cause drastic cuts to vital public services, including schools, colleges, and other programs that are so important to the people of Seattle.

This initiative seeks to reinstate the unconstitutional supermajority requirement that was struck down in 2013, which would make it extremely difficult to comply with the *McLeary* mandate to fully fund public schools.

This legislation urges Seattle voters to oppose I-1366 in the November 3,2015 general election.
