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1. BILL SUMMARY

Legislation Title: AN ORDINANCE relating to taxation of utilities in The City of Seattle; amending Section 5.48.050 of the Seattle Municipal Code.

Summary and background of the Legislation:

The Seattle Municipal Code requires that utilities operating within the City of Seattle must pay utility taxes. Unlike the majority of other utility taxes, taxes on drainage and wastewater systems currently only apply to municipal utilities. This legislation proposes a technical amendment to the Code to make these utility taxes apply to both municipal and port district utilities. After this Ordinance is adopted, all drainage and wastewater utilities from both municipal and port district utilities utilities would be subject to the taxes authorized in SMC 5.48.050.
