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## Budget Action description:

This green sheet would amend Council Bill 118512 and recommend passage as amended. As introduced, the Bill declares eight City Light former Substations in West Seattle surplus to the City's needs and authorizes City Light to sell them. The amendment, which is shown in redline in the attachment to this green sheet, would transfer jurisdiction of the Dumar and Dakota sites to FAS and authorize FAS to:

- Sell Dumar for fair market value after two years from the effective date of this ordinance. The purpose of the delay is to allow time for a possible rezone of the site from residential to commercial. This is at the request of the Highland Park community; and
- Sell Dakota to a non-profit community group for fair market value to be held as open space in perpetuity. If no community group purchases the property within two years of the effective date of the ordinance, FAS may sell it on the open market for fair market value.

To facilitate the transfer of jurisdiction, this green sheet also increases appropriation authority in the General Government Facilities – General BCL of FAS by \$750,000 to allow it to pay City Light the fair market value of the sites. The green sheet uses FAS Fund Balance as the source of the funds.

When FAS sells the properties it will replenish its Fund Balance. The anticipated increase in the land value should compensate FAS for the carrying costs over the period.

The proposed amendments to the Bill are shown in attachment <u>SCL SW Seattle Surplus Property Disposition</u> <u>D3 ORD</u> to this green sheet.
