CITY OF SEATTLE 1 ORDINANCE 124946 2 COUNCIL BILL 3 4 AN ORDINANCE accepting the gift of an automated bicycle counter display and funding for 5 installation of the display. 6 7 WHEREAS, The City of Seattle (City), through the Seattle Department of Transportation 8 (SDOT), currently conducts systematic counts of cyclists to monitor the number of 9 cyclists using the City's transportation network; and 10 WHEREAS, SDOT is seeking to extend the value of its existing systematic counts of bicycles by 11 collecting data using permanent counters at select locations, including the Second 12 Avenue protected bicycle lanes, to enable modeling of weekly, monthly, and annual 13 bicycle volumes from existing systematic count data; and 14 WHEREAS, Commute Seattle wishes to make a gift of a pole-mounted eco-display and \$9,300 15 16 for installation of the display; and WHEREAS, while the City is open to accepting third party private donations to pay for 17 additional automated bicycle counting equipment contingent on the ability of the City to 18 operate and maintain such equipment; NOW, THEREFORE, 19 BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY OF SEATTLE AS FOLLOWS: 20 Section 1. The Director of Transportation is authorized to accept the gift of an Eco-21 display, and \$9,300 for installation of the display. 22 Section 2. The Director of Transportation is authorized to install the gifted bicycle 23 display on the east side of Second Avenue between Madison and Marion Streets to count 24 bicycles using the Second Avenue protected bicycle lanes, and The City of Seattle shall own the 25 counter, the Eco-display, and resulting data, and shall maintain these as funds allow. 26

Section 3. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force 30 days after its approval by 1 the Mayor, but if not approved and returned by the Mayor within ten days after presentation, it 2 shall take effect as provided by Seattle Municipal Code Section 1.04.020. 3 Passed by the City Council the 30 day of NOVEMBER, 2015, and 4 signed by me in open session in authentication of its passage this 5 day of NOVEMBER, 2015. 6 7 8 of the City Council President 9 10 Approved by me this 4 day of Dec who, 2015. 11 12 13 Edward B.
