1. BILL SUMMARY

Legislation Title: A RESOLUTION relating to low income housing; accompanying an ordinance requesting the 2016 Housing Levy Renewal and providing further direction regarding implementation of the programs to be funded by such levy.

Summary and background of the Legislation: The Mayor and the City Council are submitting to the voters a \$290 million, seven-year low-income housing levy (“2016 Housing Levy”) as authorized in CB 118656. If the Levy measure is approved by the voter, the Executive will be submitting to the City Council for approval, the Levy Administration and Finance Plan that establishes the policies for implementing the Levy programs. This Resolution provides guidance to the Executive on the specific policy and program development work that will be done in order to prepare the Levy Administration and Finance Plan for submittal to the Council, in early 2017.
