Legislation Title: AN ORDINANCE relating to international affairs and the Seattle Sister Cities program, amending Sections 3.14.440, 3.14.450, 3.14.460, and 3.14.470 of the Seattle Municipal Code.

By renaming it the Seattle International Affairs Advisory Board and broadening its scope, the Advisory Board can better serve the City's strategic international engagement while maintaining traditional oversight of the Sister Cities Program.
