BACKGROUND

- Since 1966, SPR has been successful in securing RCO funding, averaging between \$500,000 to \$1M in years we apply
- ▶RCO is one of our largest funders, supplementing CIP and past Levy funding
- To date we have received over \$36 million dollars for 127 projects.
- ▶The ALEA grant program requires a 1 to 1 match, and that the project will be operated and maintained for a minimum of 25 years for the purposes for which funding is sought.
- ➤ Grants are awarded based on a public, competitive process which weighs the merits of proposed projects against established program criteria.

Project Summary: Arboretum Trail


- ► Improvements include:
 - Rebuild and replace portions of a boardwalk to Foster Island
 - Retrofit floating walkway for safety and ADA compliance
 - > Build elevated walkway over marshy trail
- ▶RCO Grant Request: \$475,000
- ► Total Project Budget: \$950,000
- ▶ Project Start Date: Fall 2017

- ▶ Parks and Recreation intends to apply for funding through the RCO Washington Wildlife Recreation Program (WWRP) program in 2016.
- ▶\$500,000 funding requests will be made for each Brighton and Smith Cove playfields.
- A \$475,000 WWRP funding request will be made for the Arboretum Waterfront Trail.

PROJECT SUMMARY: SMITH COVE

- ► Improvements include:
 - > Add playfield drainage and irrigation
 - Replace aging grass turf with new grass
 - Change field layout for multi-sport use
 - Regrade area to correct playfield slant
 - > Add ADA accessibility
- ▶RCO Grant Request: \$500,000
- ► Total Project Budget: \$1,000,570
- ▶ Project Start Date: Fall 2017

PROJECT SUMMARY: BRIGHTON PLAYFIELD

- ► Improvements include:
 - > Replace existing turf with synthetic
 - > Add drainage and adequate aprons
 - > Replace existing lighting with LED
 - Redesign field to accommodate more sports and simultaneous games
 - Add ADA compliant access and seating
- ▶RCO Grant Request: \$500,000
- ► Total Project Budget: \$3,829,613
- ▶ Project Start Date: Summer 2017


