CITY OF SEATTLE 1 **ORDINANCE** 2 COUNCIL BILL 118768 3 4 AN ORDINANCE relating to historic preservation; imposing controls upon the Gaslight Inn, a 5 landmark designated by the Landmarks Preservation Board under Chapter 25.12 of the 6 Seattle Municipal Code, and adding it to the Table of Historical Landmarks contained in 7 Chapter 25.32 of the Seattle Municipal Code. 8 9 WHEREAS, the Landmarks Preservation Ordinance, Chapter 25.12 of the Seattle Municipal 10 Code (SMC), establishes a procedure for the designation and preservation of sites, 11 improvements, and objects having historical, cultural, architectural, engineering, or 12 geographic significance; and 13 WHEREAS, the Landmarks Preservation Board ("Board"), after a public meeting on August 19, 14 2015, voted to approve the nomination of the improvement located at 1727 15th Avenue 15 and the site on which the improvement is located (which collectively are referred to as 16 the "Gaslight Inn" for the purposes of this ordinance) for designation as a landmark under 17 SMC Chapter 25.12; and 18 WHEREAS, after a public meeting on October 7, 2015, the Board voted to approve the 19 designation of the Gaslight Inn under SMC Chapter 25.12; and 20 WHEREAS, on December 16, 2015, the Board and the owner of the designated landmark agreed 21 to controls and incentives; and 22 WHEREAS, the Board recommends that the City Council enact a designating ordinance 23 approving the controls and incentives; NOW, THEREFORE, 24 BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY OF SEATTLE AS FOLLOWS: 25 Section 1. DESIGNATION: Pursuant to Seattle Municipal Code (SMC) 25.12.660, the 26 designation by the Landmarks Preservation Board ("Board") of the improvement located at 1727 27

4	Chapter 25.12, or the time for denying a Certificate of Approval must have expired, before the

7	2. No Certificate of Approval is required for the following:			
8	a. Any in-kind maintenance or repairs of the features or			
9	characteristics of the Gaslight Inn that were designated by the Board for preservation.			
10	b. Installation, removal or alteration of the following landscape			
11	elements: trees less than 8 inches in diameter measured 4 1/2 feet above ground; shrubs;			
12	perennials; and annuals.			
13	c. Installation, removal, or alteration of the following temporary site			
14	furnishings: benches, movable planter boxes, and movable water features.			
15	d. Installation or repair of underground utilities and irrigation,			
16	provided that the site is restored in kind.			
17	e. Installation, removal, or alteration of non-illuminated exterior			
18	signage less than 6 square feet in area.			
19	f. Painting of interior surfaces currently painted, and carpeting of			
20	surfaces currently carpeted, as depicted in the nomination application.			
21	g. Installation, removal, or alteration of temporary interior window			
22	coverings.			
23	h. Installation of a gas fireplace on the north wall of the parlor			
24	(former ballroom) to mirror the existing fireplace on the south wall of the living room if: the			

form, materials, and details of the gas fireplace, mantle, and hearth are similar to the details of the existing fireplace, mantle, and hearth (a difference in tile color is acceptable); and the exterior alterations are limited to a through-wall vent.

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## B. City Historic Preservation Officer Approval Process.

- 1. The City Historic Preservation Officer (CHPO) may review and approve alterations or significant changes to the features or characteristics listed in subsection 2.B.3 of this ordinance according to the following procedure:
- a. The owner shall submit to the CHPO a written request for the alterations or significant changes, including applicable drawings or specifications.
- b. If the CHPO, upon examination of submitted plans and specifications, determines that the alterations or significant changes are consistent with the purposes of SMC Chapter 25.12, the CHPO shall approve the alterations or significant changes without further action by the Board.
- 2. If the CHPO does not approve the alterations or significant changes, the owner may submit revised materials to the CHPO, or apply to the Board for a Certificate of Approval under SMC Chapter 25.12. The CHPO shall transmit a written decision on the owner's request to the owner within 14 days of receipt of the request. Failure of the CHPO to timely transmit a written decision constitutes approval of the request.
- 3. CHPO approval of alterations or significant changes to the features or characteristics of the Gaslight Inn that were designated by the Board for preservation is available for the following:
- a. For the specified features and characteristics of the building, the addition or elimination of ducts, conduits, HVAC vents, grilles, pipes, and other similar wiring or mechanical elements necessary for the normal operation of the building.

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Section 4. Enforcement of this ordinance and penalties for its violation are as provided in SMC 25.12.910.

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Section 5. The Gaslight Inn is hereby added alphabetically to Section I, Residences, of the Table of Historical Landmarks contained in SMC Chapter 25.32.

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Section 6. The City Clerk is directed to record a certified copy of this ordinance with the King County Director of Records and Elections, deliver two certified copies to the CHPO, and deliver one copy to the Director of the Seattle Department of Construction and Inspections. The CHPO is directed to provide a certified copy of this ordinance to the owner of the landmark.

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1.	Section 7. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force 30 days after its approval by
2	the Mayor, but if not approved and returned by the Mayor within ten days after presentation, it
3	shall take effect as provided by Seattle Municipal Code Section 1.04.020.
