#### **Budget Action description:**

This green sheet would add \$100,050 in 2017 and \$100,050 in 2018 in GSF to the Office of City Auditor's budget to complete a rental market study. Both the Source of Income legislation (ORD 125114) and the pending Move-in Fee legislation (CB 118817) call for evaluations conducted by the Office of City Auditor or, at the Auditor's discretion, an independent, outside party. Resources to complete the Source of Income evaluation were not identified prior to adoption. The move-in fee legislation is pending legislation. Because of the timing of implementation, an impact evaluation that requires having a baseline evaluation completed prior to implementation is not possible.

The Auditor has prepared a proposal to work with outside experts to conduct a housing market study to better understand the housing-market dynamics in Seattle and enhance the City's ability to: evaluate the effectiveness and potential unintended consequences of these and other related housing regulations; and

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provide information for the development of additional policy strategies for improving housing access and affordability, preventing displacement, and affirmatively furthering integration. This request would provide funding that would include analysis of information from multiple data sources to provide a more comprehensive picture of the rental and conduct in-depth interviews/focus groups with key informants (housing providers, landlord associations, renter associations, etc.).
