It was here he met his mentor, Luversa Sullivan, who taught him about the lifelong learning model, which states the highest stage of learning is sharing what you have learned. He has since dedicated his life to sharing his experiences with likeminded youth and adults.

Today Owuor is active as an impresario, bridging the gap globally between artists and creatives everywhere. He's an international touring artist; producer for CS2&3 television programs, a cross-cultural exchange between African musicians; and global ambassador for programs like the US State Department Program 1Beat and 1 Vibe Africa. In all of his various musical roles, Owuor continually works to advocate for the value of music education and works to build a healthy music community locally and globally.
