

Proposed Schedule

2016

- MBHA closes and takes title on properties
- Prospective Purchaser Consent Decree filed

2017

- Proposed adoption of Redevelopment Opportunity Zone Resolution by City Council
- Perform Remedial Investigation

2018

- Produce Final Draft Remedial Investigation Feasibility Study
- Secure Cleanup Dollars
- Close Project Financing

2019

Break Ground

2020

- Construction completed
- Ribbon cutting
- Tenants move in
