
Proposal

Bender Development LP and Bender Equities Inc. are seeking a term permit for pedestrian plaza enhancements in E Howe St right-of-way:

- Includes art, landscaping, pedestrian level lighting, benches, a view overlook and a connection to the new stairs west of the site
- No vehicular access is permitted
- Public plaza, approximately 5,750 sq. ft., will be maintained by the applicant for the life of the term permit
- SDOT recommends approval

Plaza located over and across E Howe St, south of Yale Place E and west of Eastlake Ave E



Background

- City Council granted subterranean vacation of a portion of E Howe St on December 15, 2014
- The public plaza was proposed and approved as public benefit for the subterranean street vacation and requires a term permit
